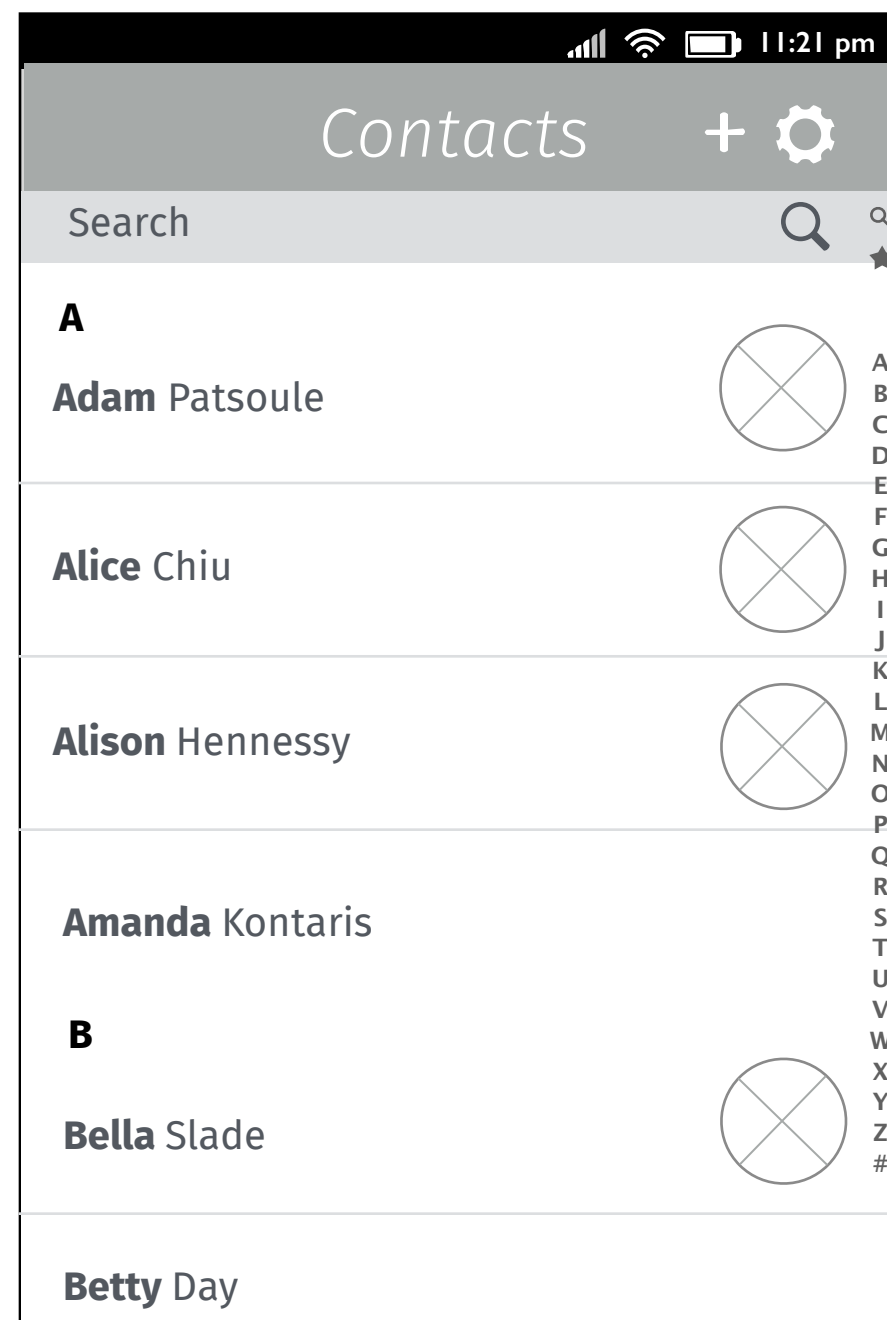

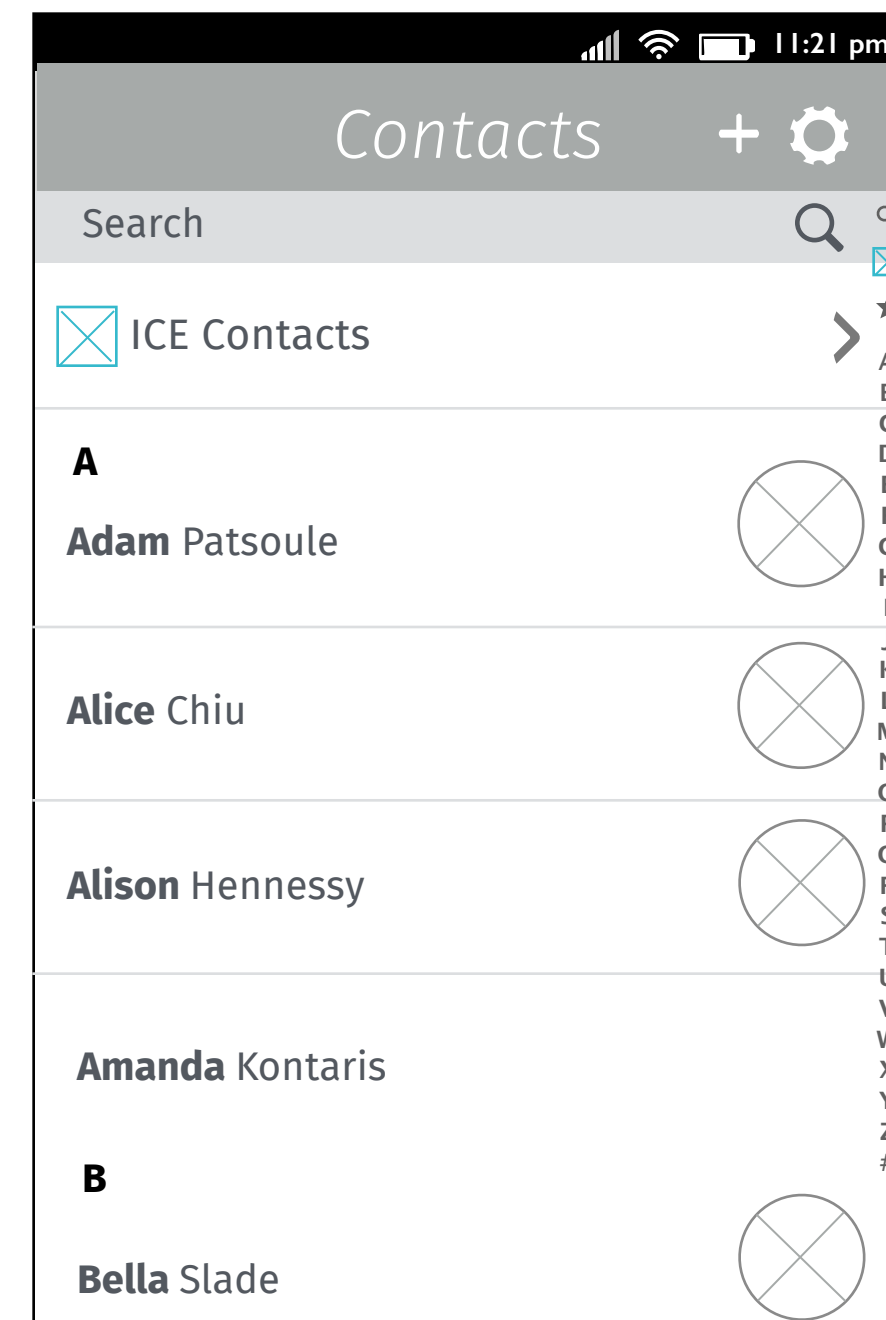

# Different views of ICE contacts in Contacts APP

Default Contacts view



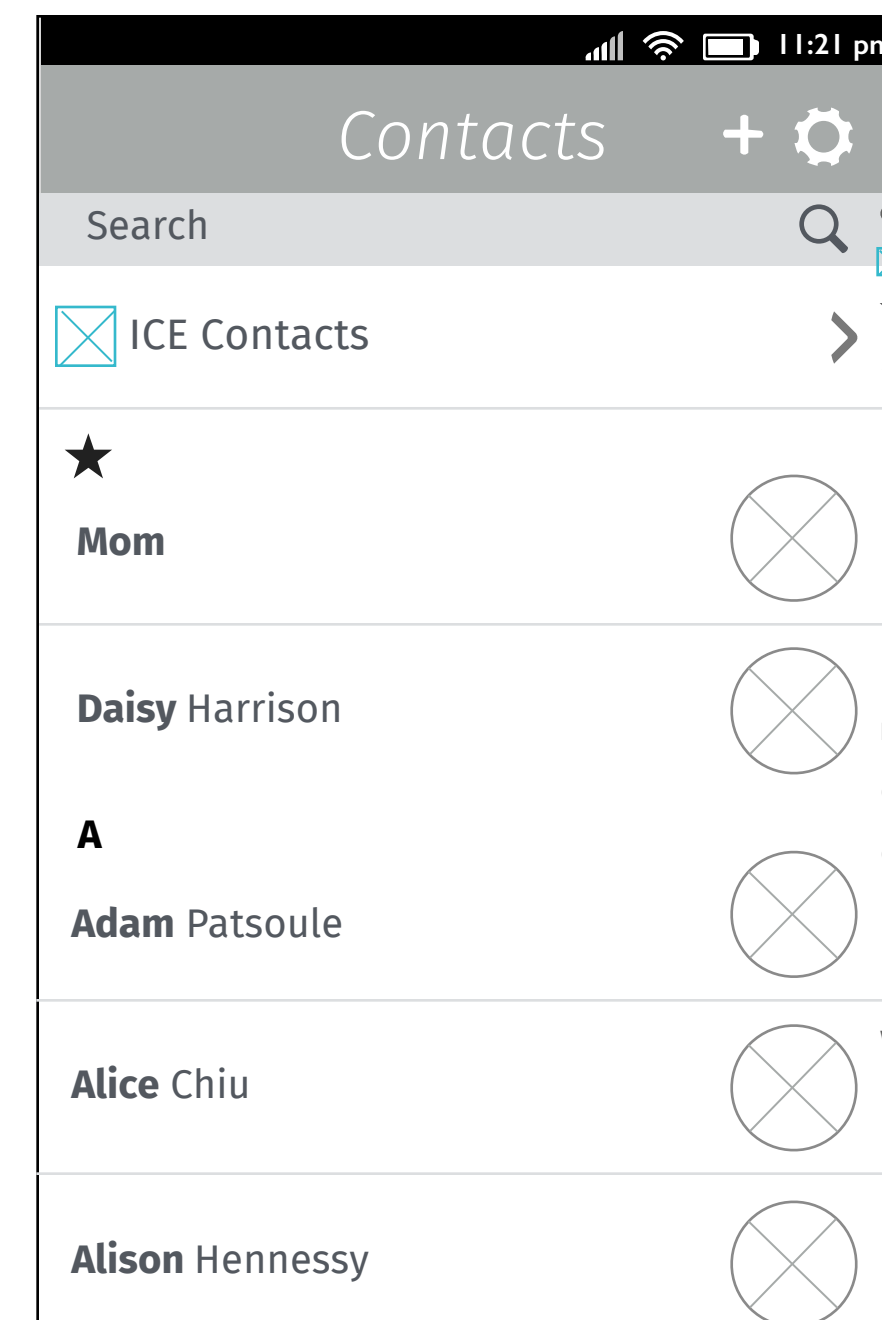
Contacts view with ICE set



The ICE contacts section will be on the top of the page with an icon design (depends on visual design). **This section appears when there has at least one ICE contact set in settings.** The contacts which are set as ICE contacts will still be shown in the contacts list below.

**The alphabetic indicator on the right will add an ICE icon as a hint.**

Contacts view with ICE & favorites set

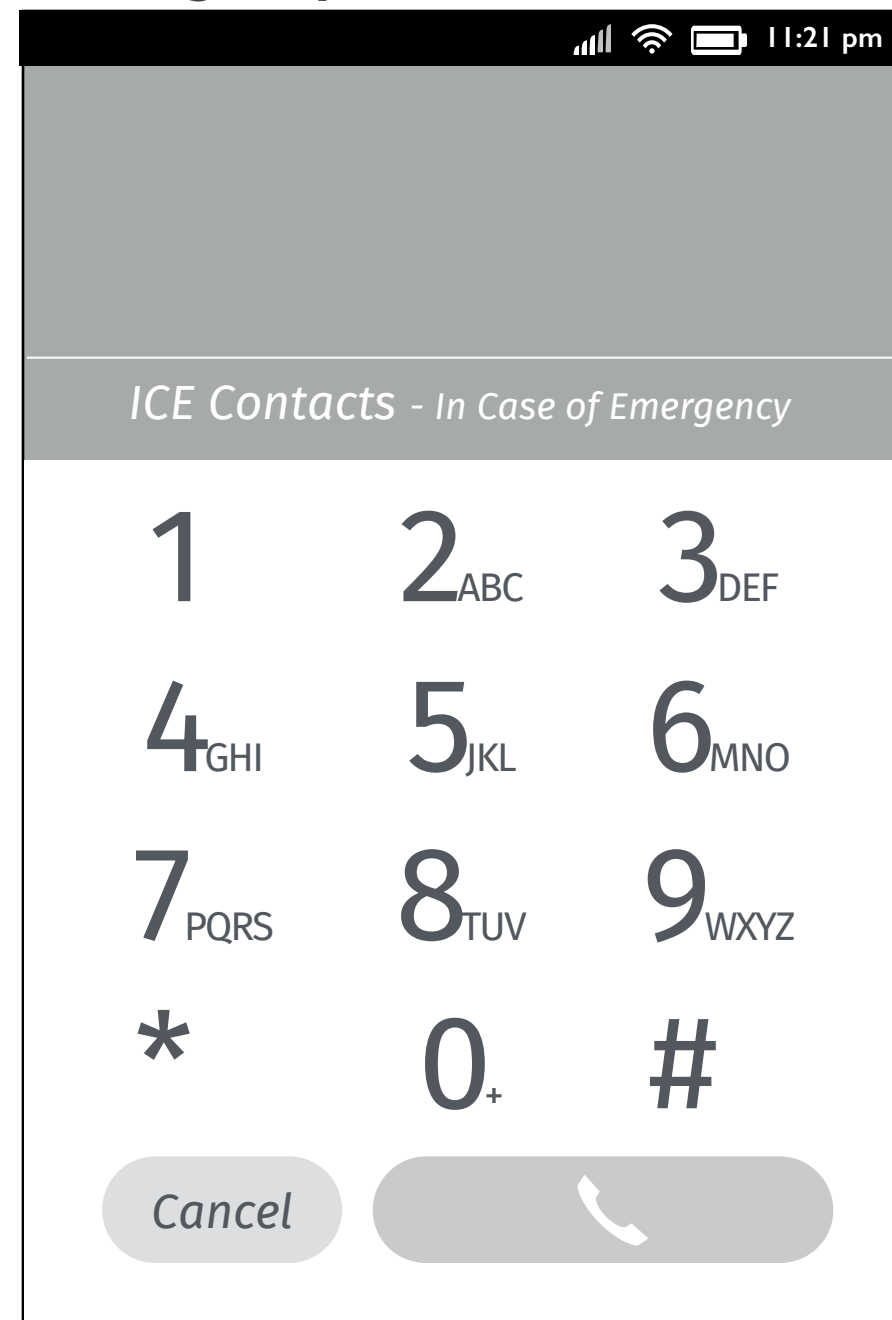


If user has set “favorite” contacts, the ICE contact section will be above the “favorites” section.

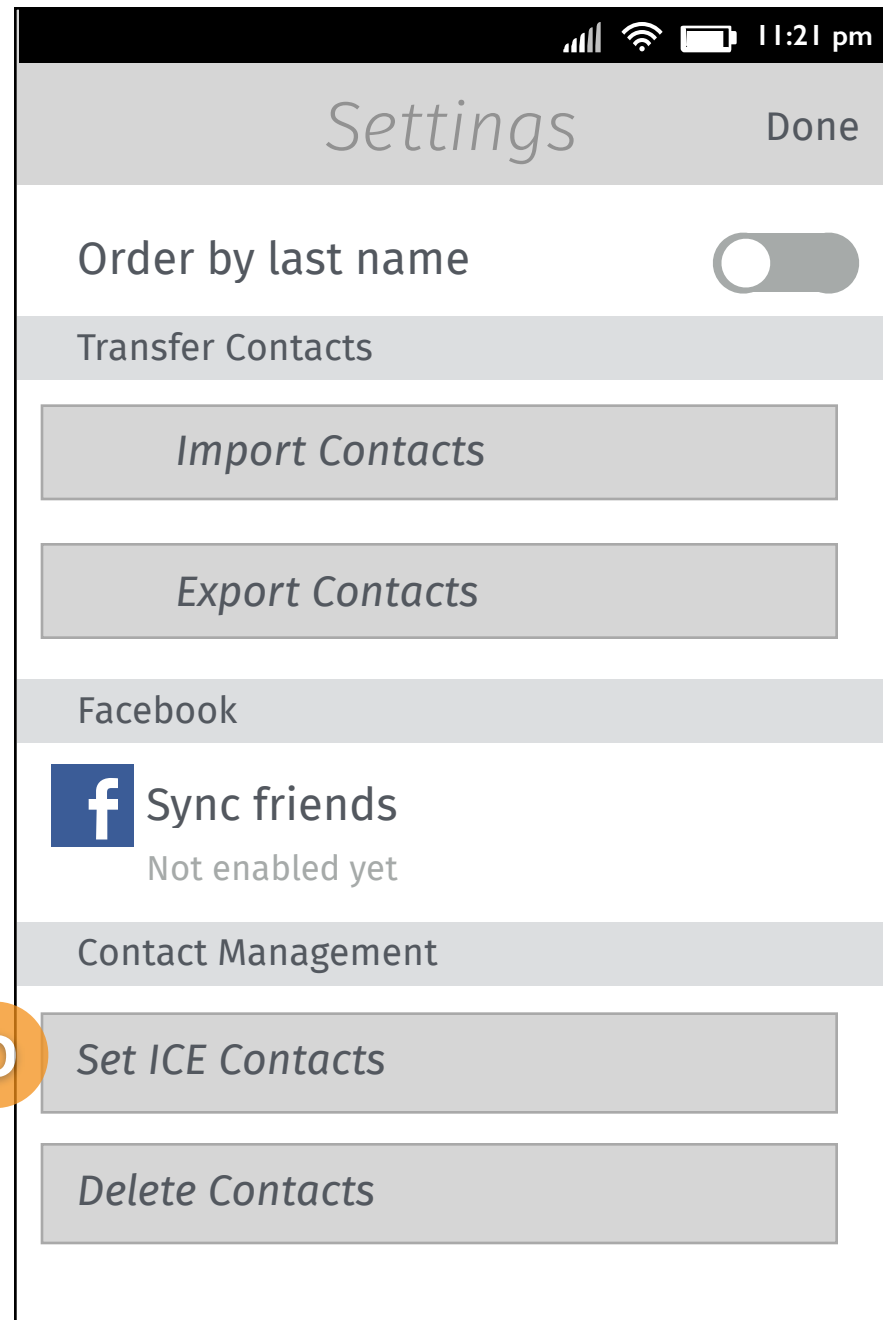
## ICE Contacts in Dialer (Emergency call mode)



If user has set ICE contact, then there will be an “ICE Contacts” section on the middle of the page (above the keypad). Users can tap it to trigger menu.

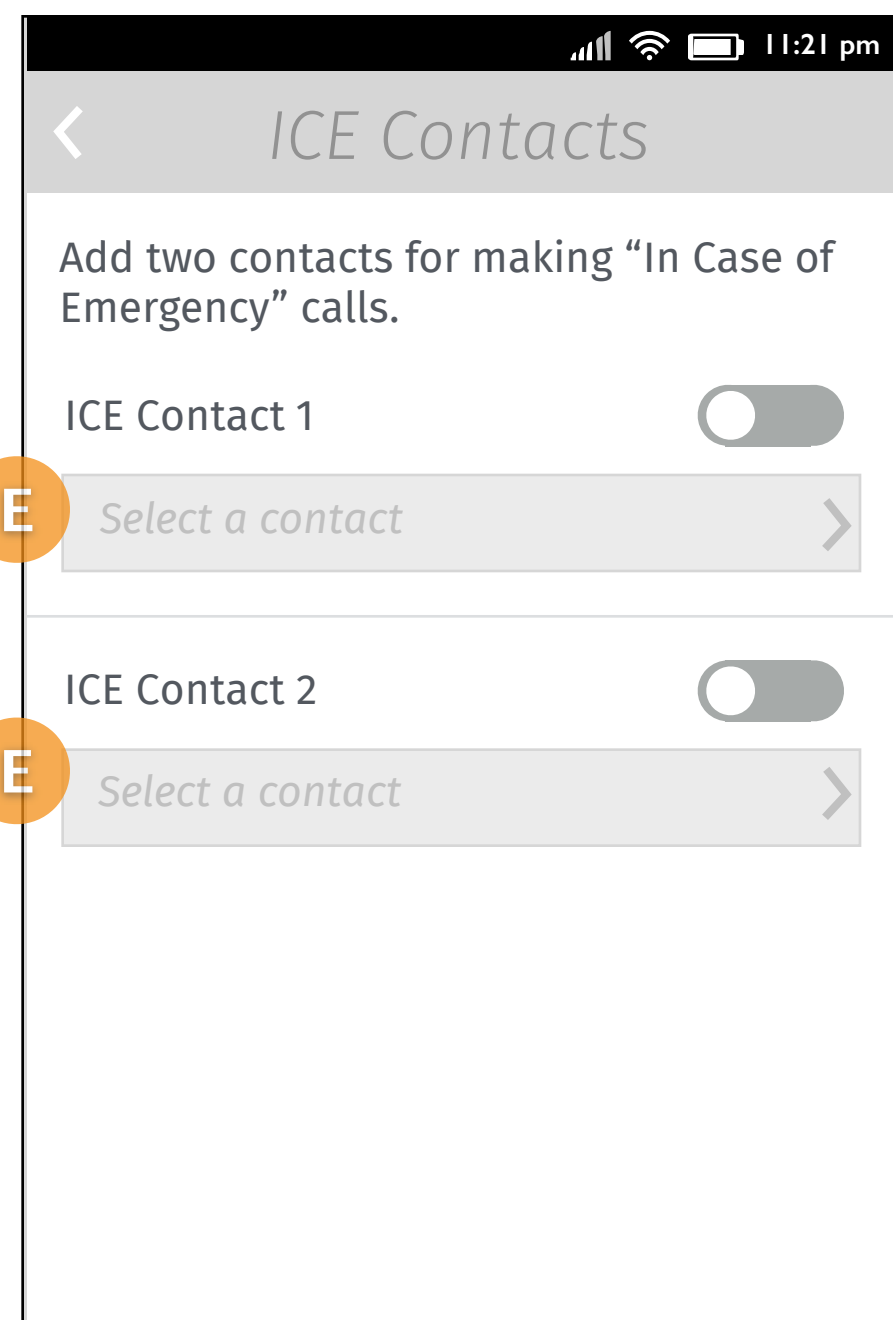
# Views of ICE contacts settings in Contacts APP

Contacts settings



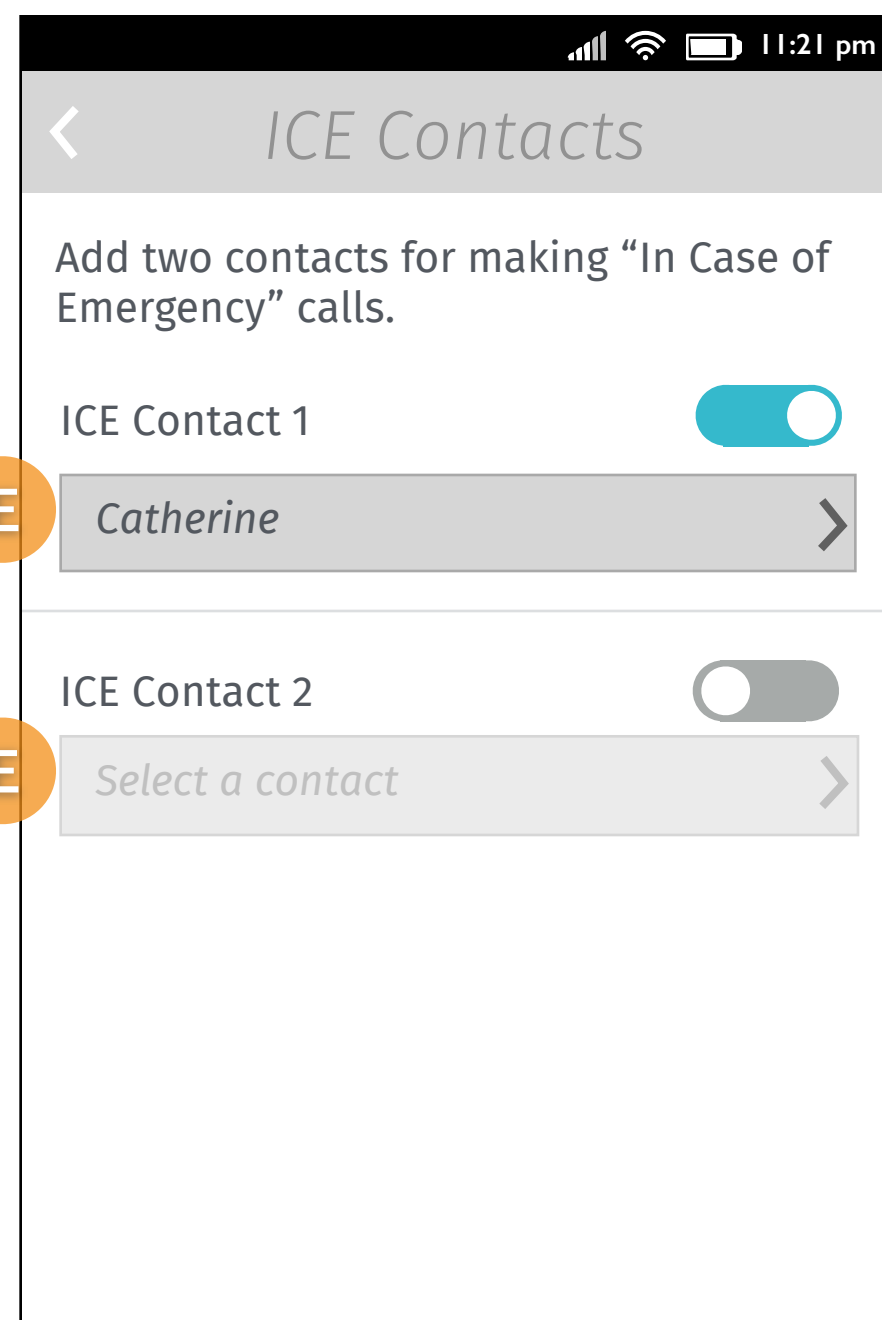
Add an option "Set ICE Contacts" in the "Contact Management" section.

ICE Contact in Contacts settings



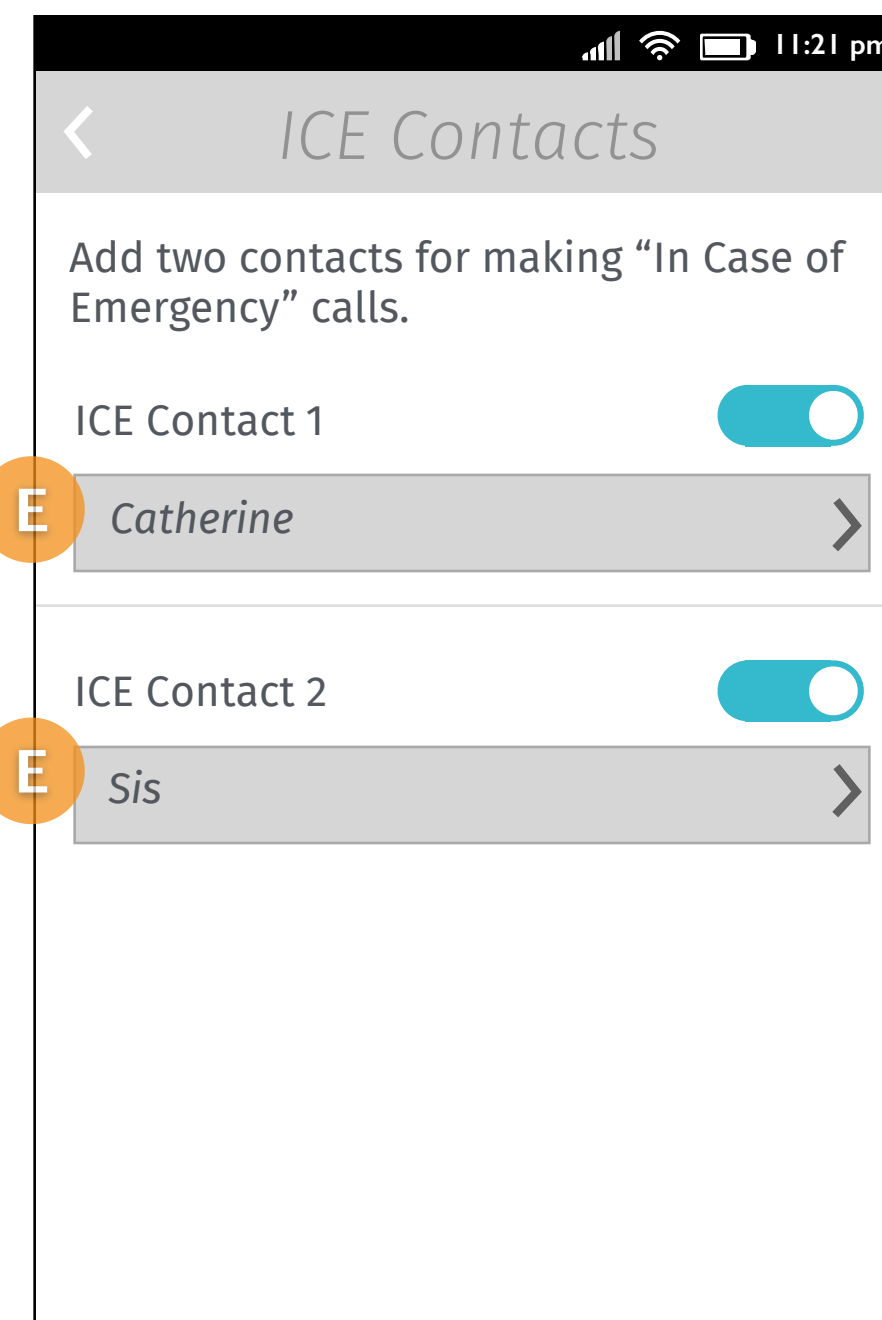
In ICE Contacts settings, users can set 2 contacts respectively for emergency calls. It shows "Select a contact" as indication when there is no contact set before. It will display contact name if user has select a contact for ICE.

ICE Contact in Contacts settings



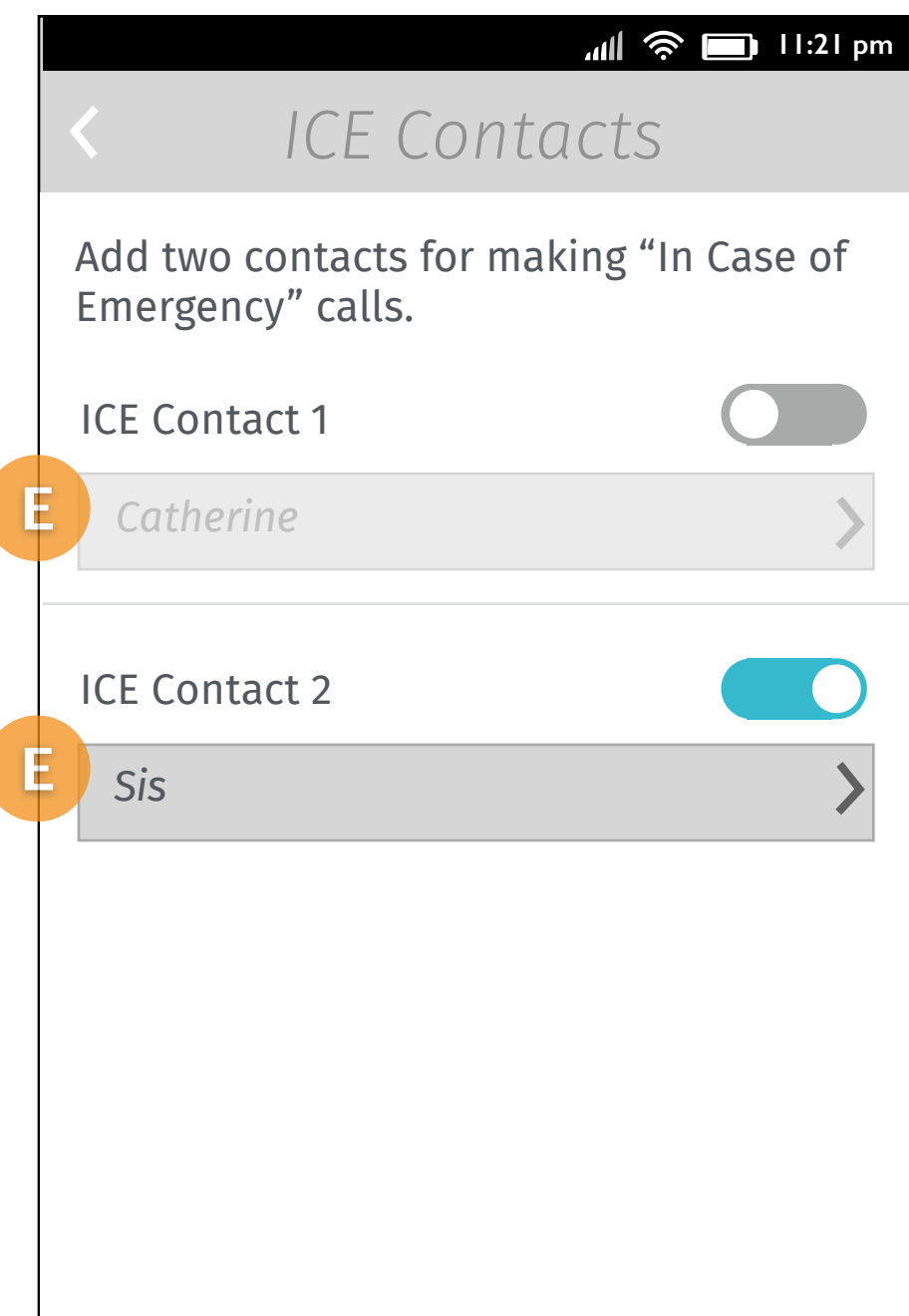
One ICE contact set.

Two ICE contact set.

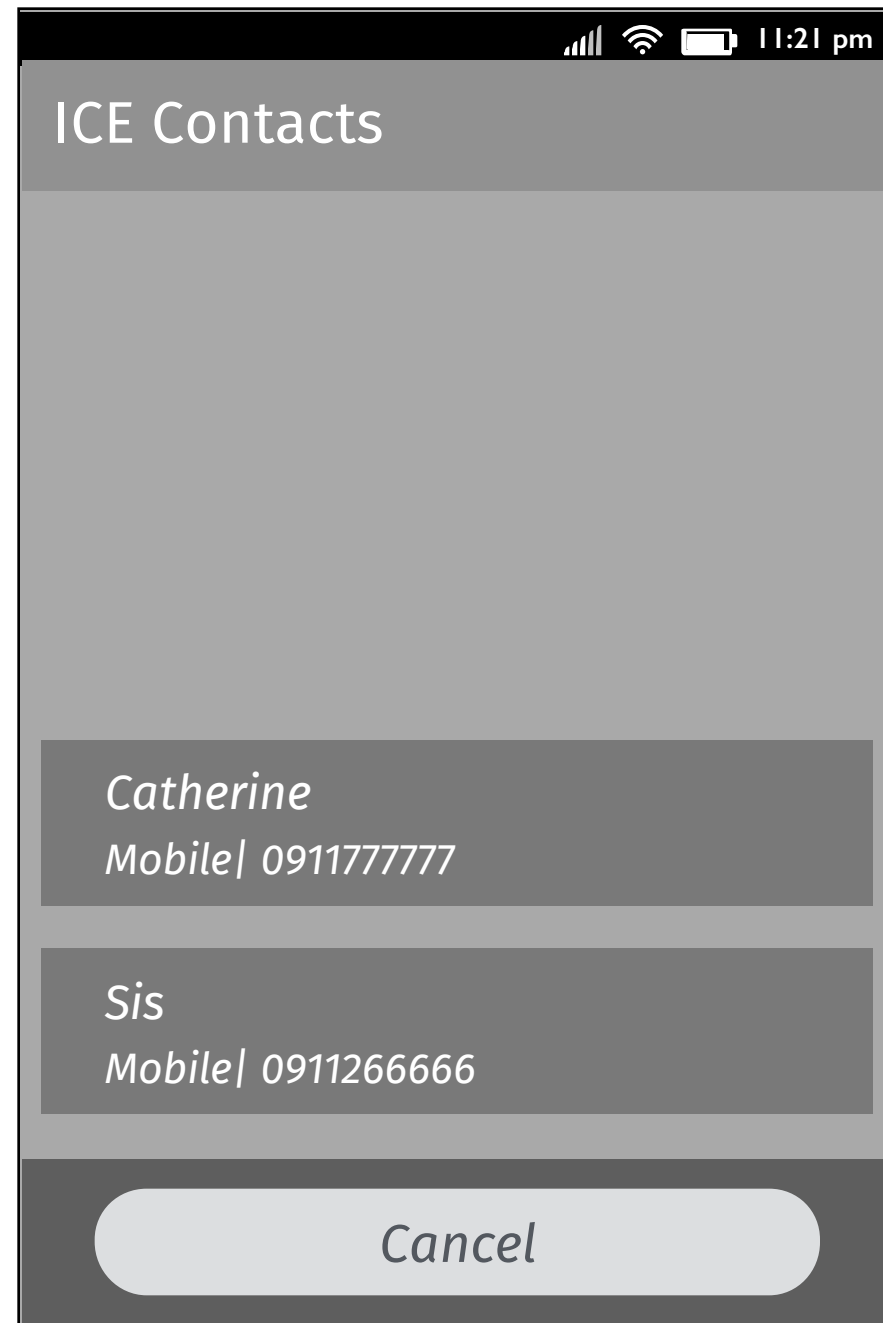
ICE Contact in Contacts settings

# Views of ICE contacts menu for making calls

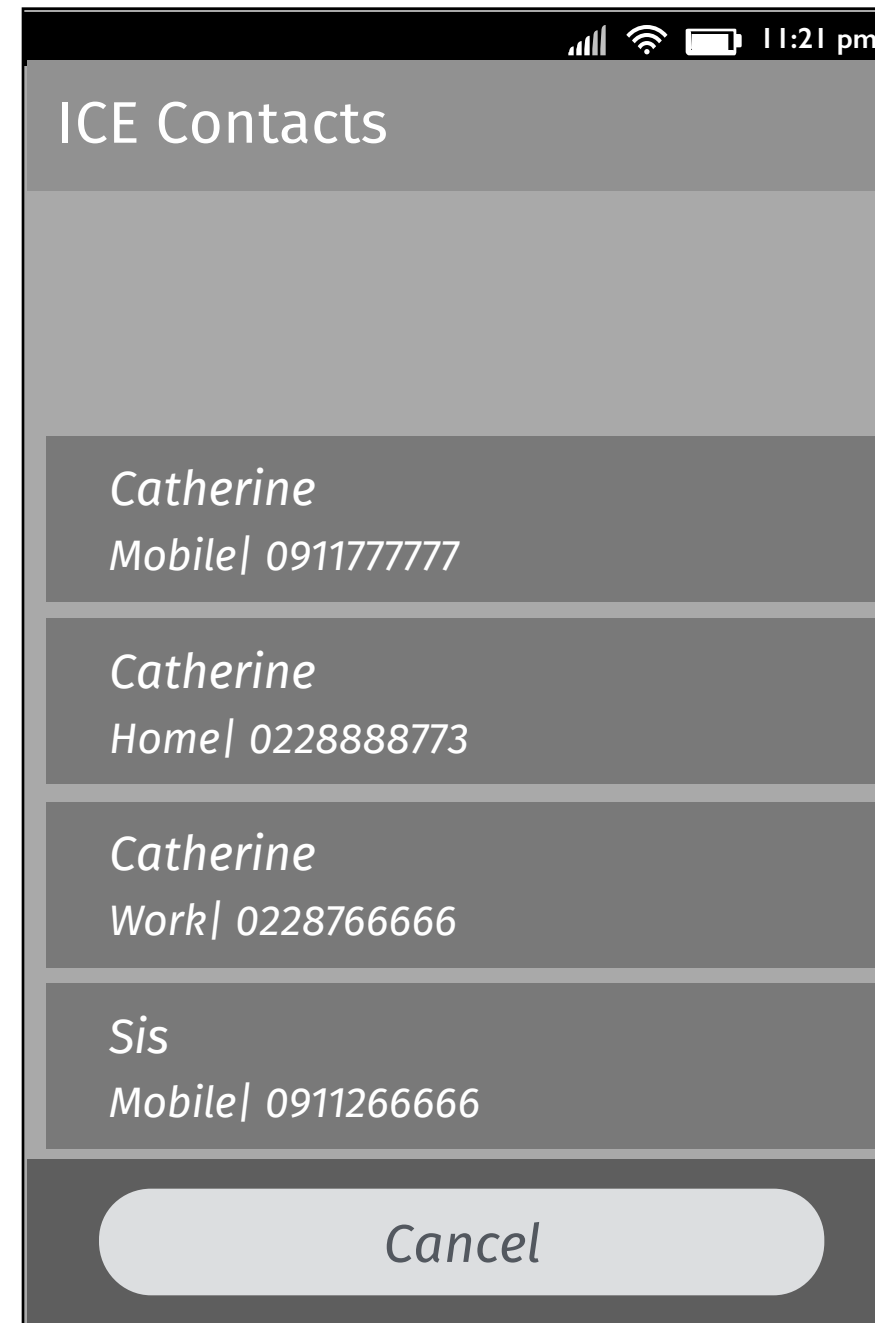
Two ICE contacts



If user has set ICE contacts, they can trigger an action menu which display 2 contacts' numbers on it.

In this case, each contact has only one number set in APP.

Two ICE contacts with more than 2 numbers



If the contact has more than one number, we display all of them on action menu. So user can decide using which one to reach the contact.

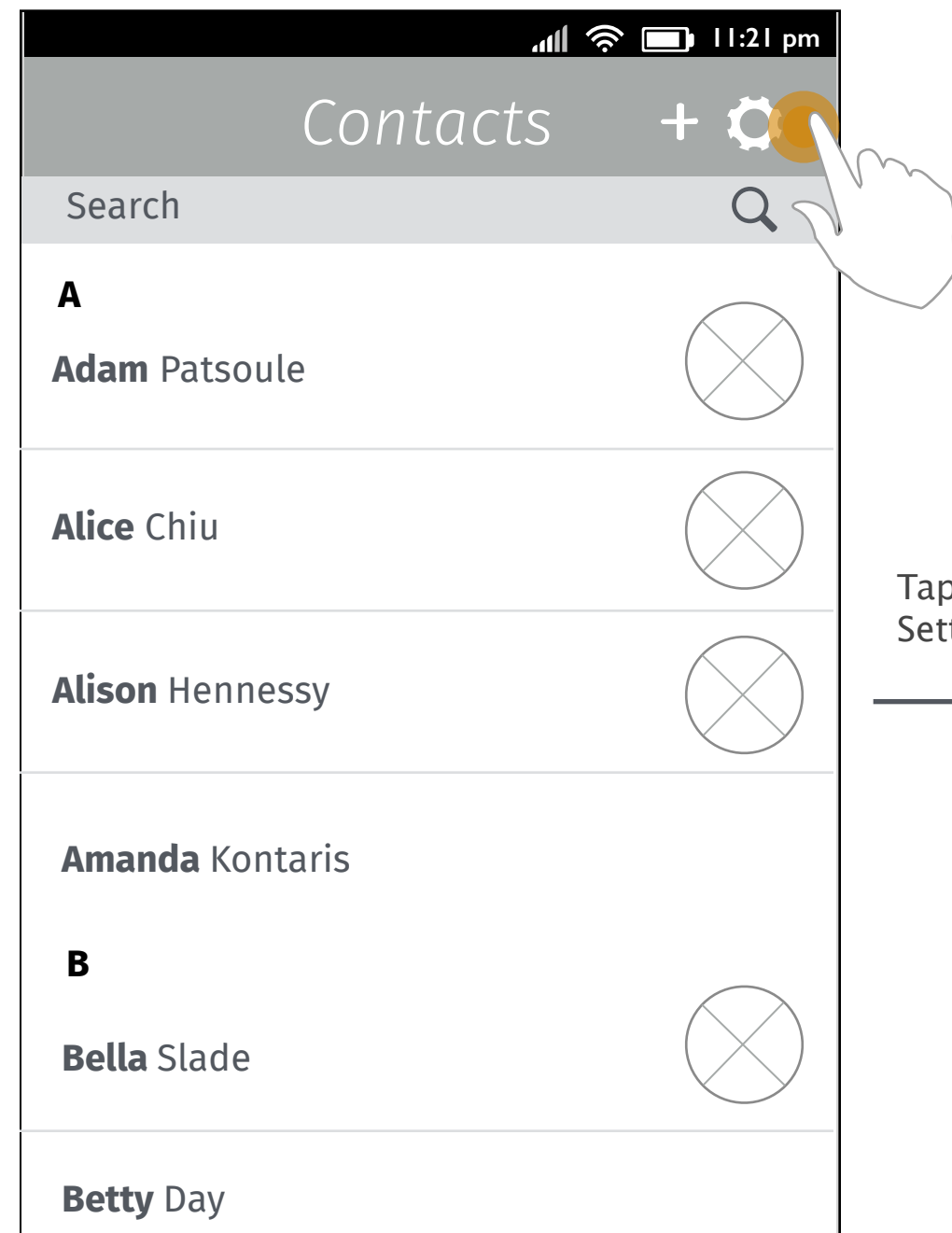
If it has more than 6 items on the page, the action menu will become scrollable.

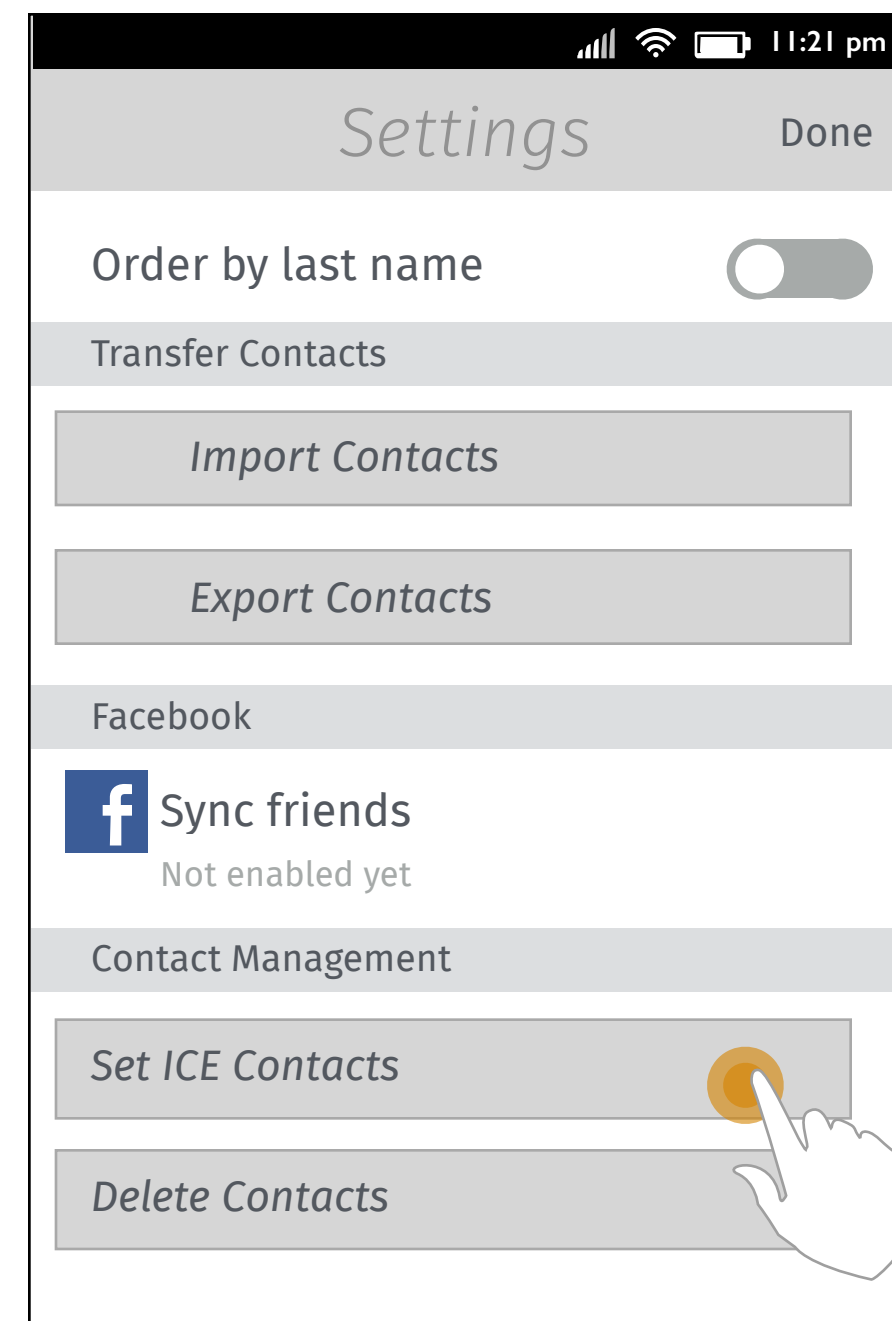
# Set ICE Contacts (1/2)

## 1. [Contacts list]



The user taps the settings button on the top right of the page in Contacts APP.

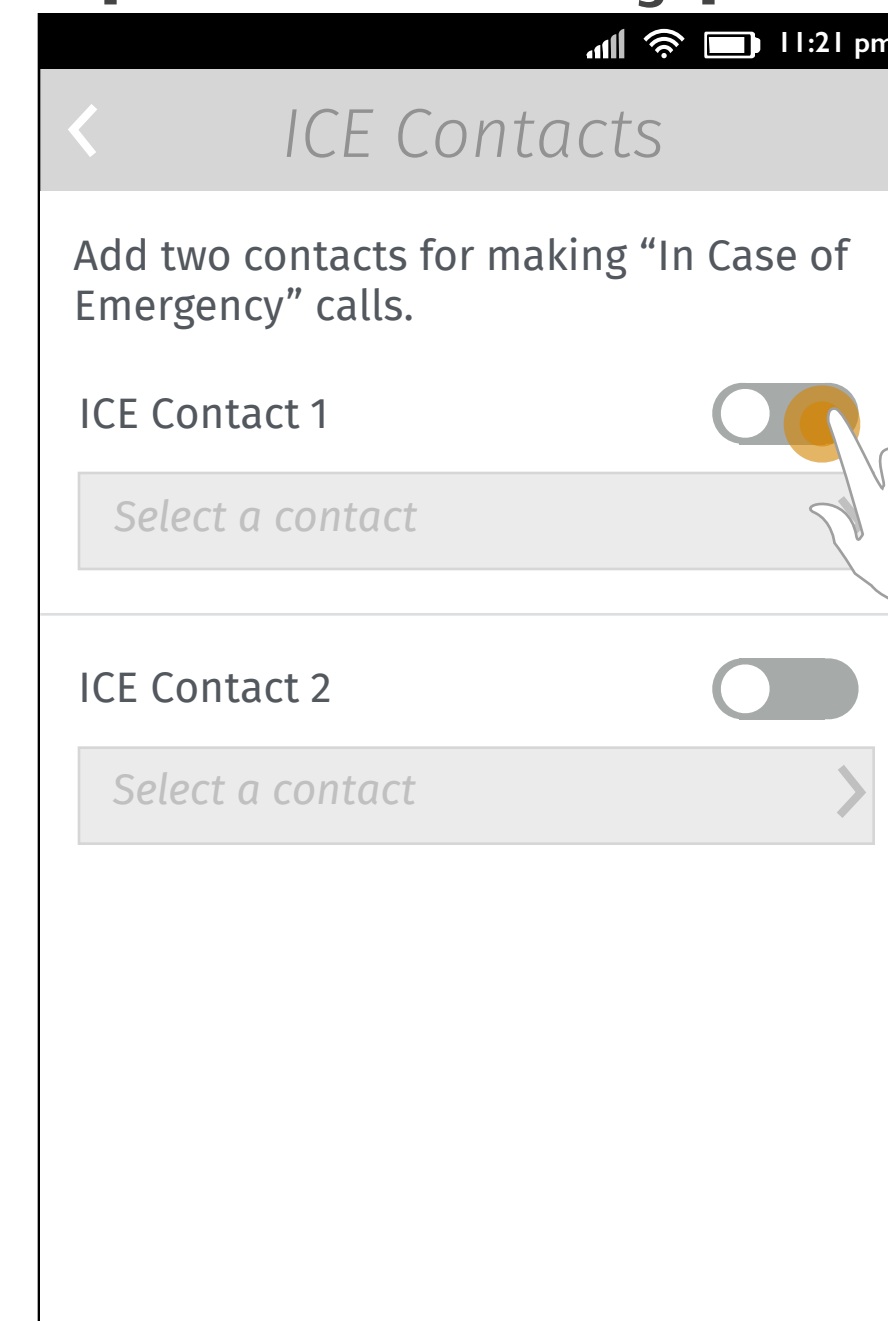
## 2. [Contacts settings]



The Settings slides up and user taps "Set ICE Contacts" from "Contact Management" section.

Tap Set ICE Contacts

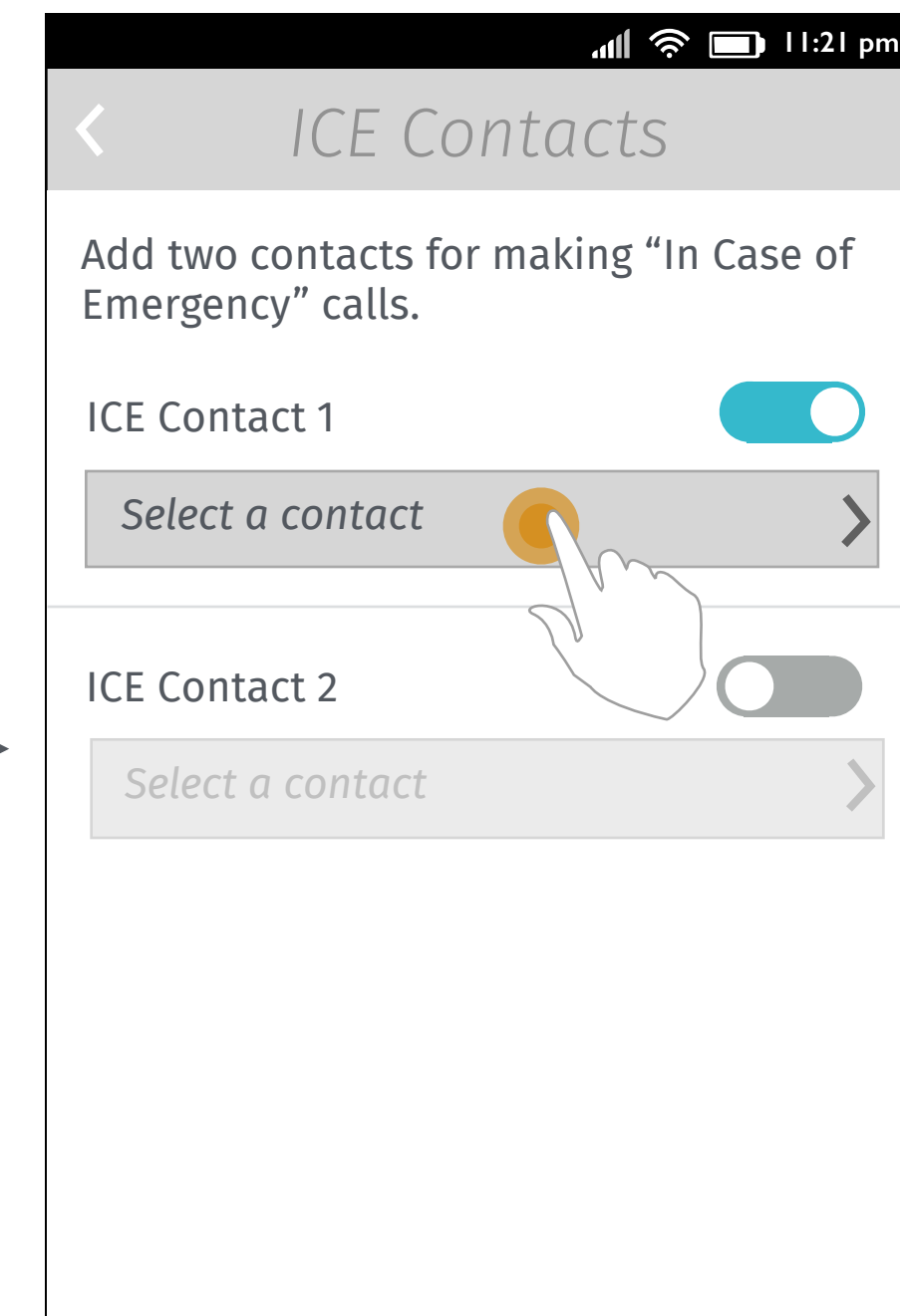
## 3. [ICE contacts settings]



Switch on ICE contact 1

User switches the ICE contact 1 on.

Tap "<" on left top to go back to Screen2.



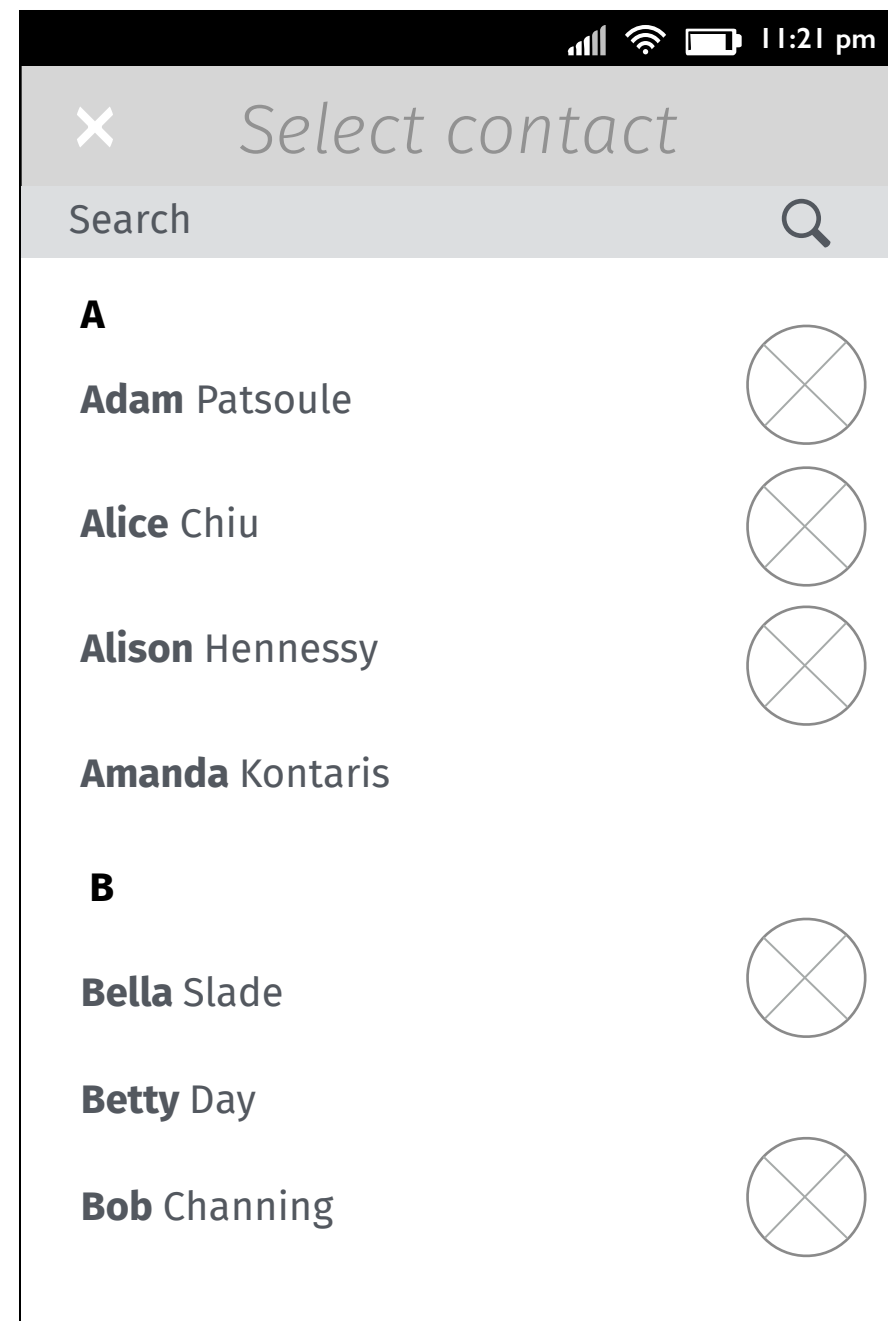
Tap "Select a contact"

The list button is enabled. User taps the list button to set the first ICE contact.

Tap "<" on left top to go back to Screen2.

## 4. [Single select mode]

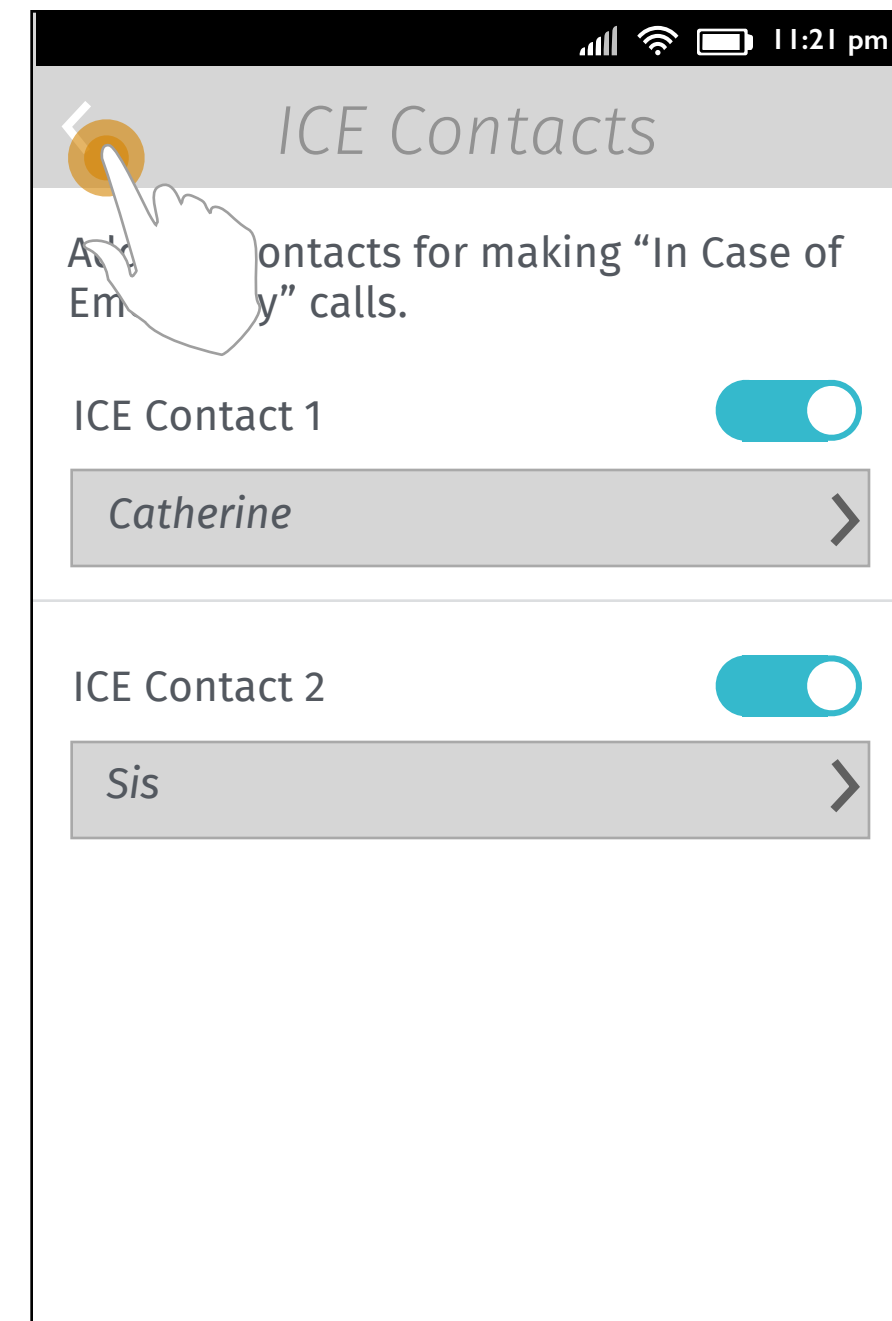


Select a contact

Single selection mode for contact list pops up and user selects one contact to close window and go to Screen 5.

Tap "x" on left top to go back to Screen 3.

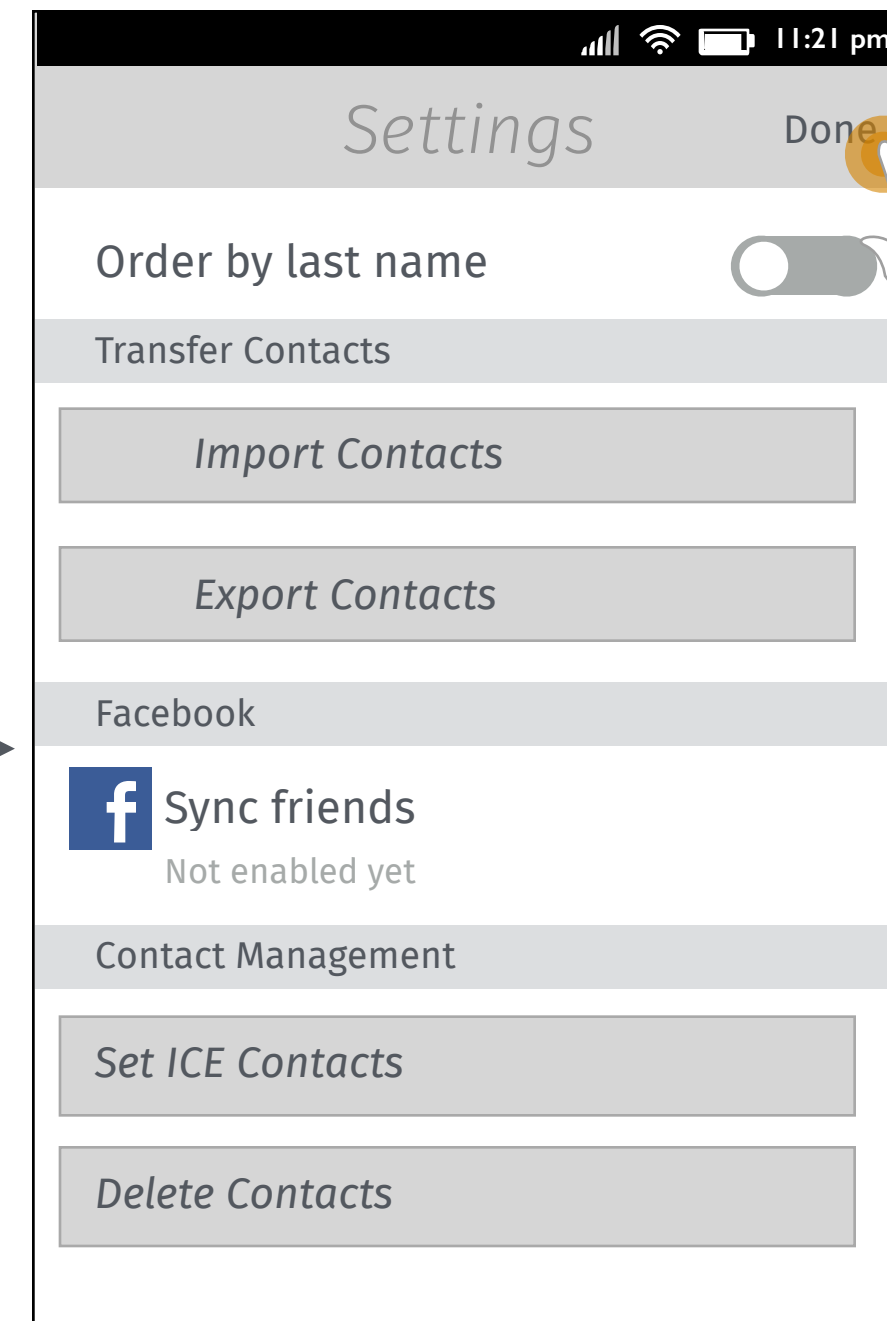
## 5. [Finish 2 ICE contact settings]



Tap back key

After finishing two ICE contacts settings, user taps back key on the top left to go back to general Contacts settings.

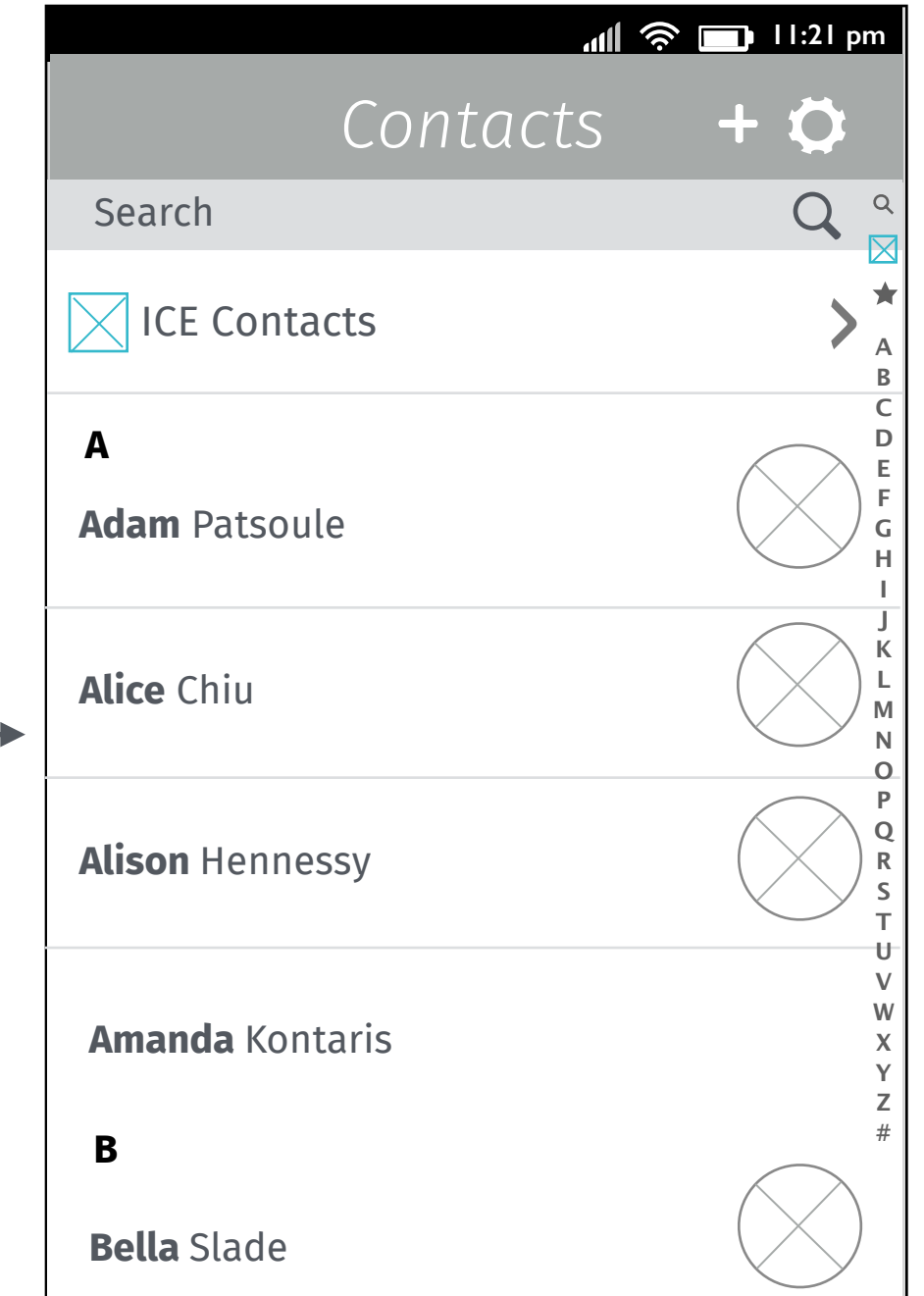
## 6. [Done Contacts settings]



Tap Done

User taps "Done" to close the Contacts settings.

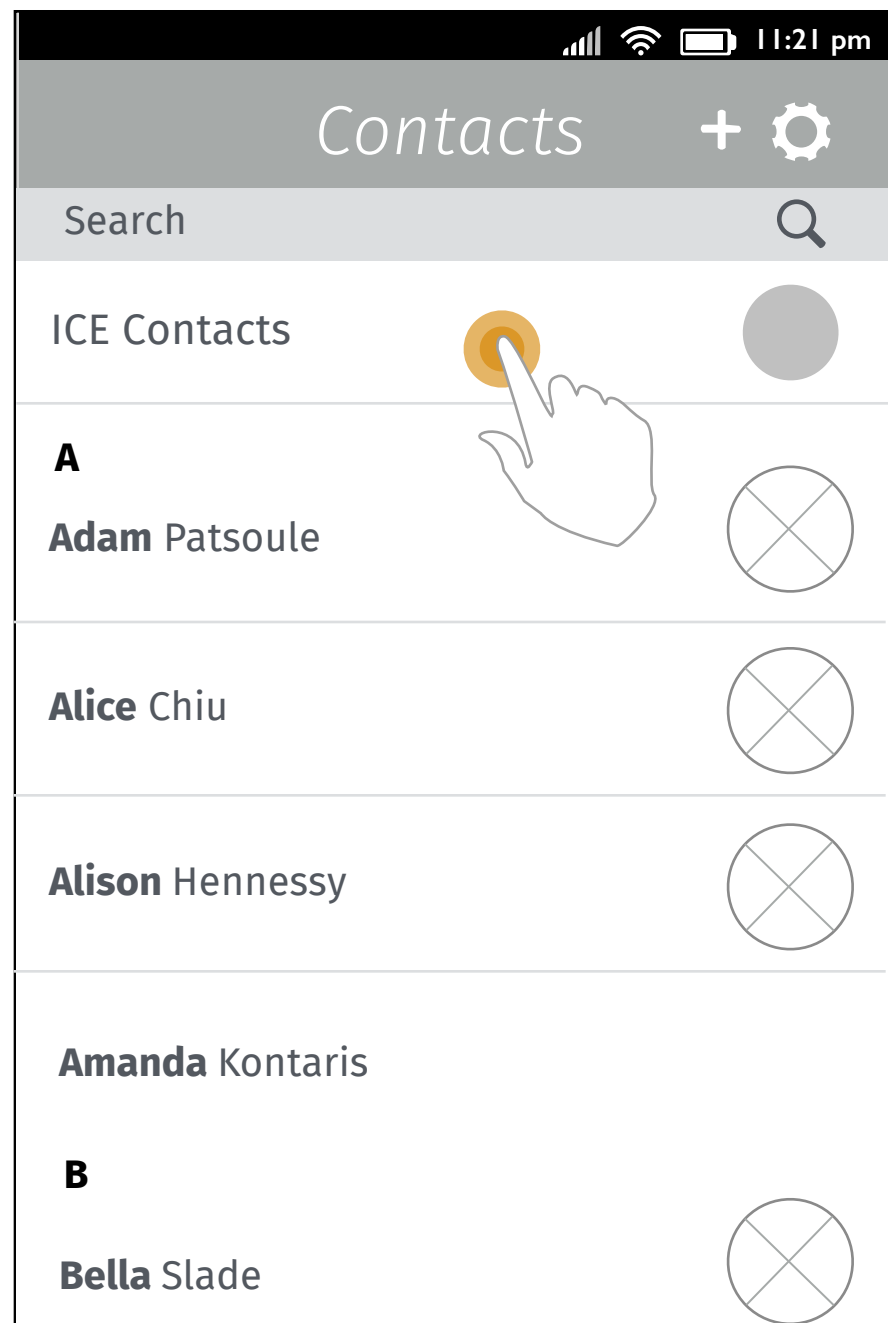
## 7. [Contacts with ICE Contacts section]



There will be an "ICE Contacts" section in Contacts APP after user has set ICE contact.

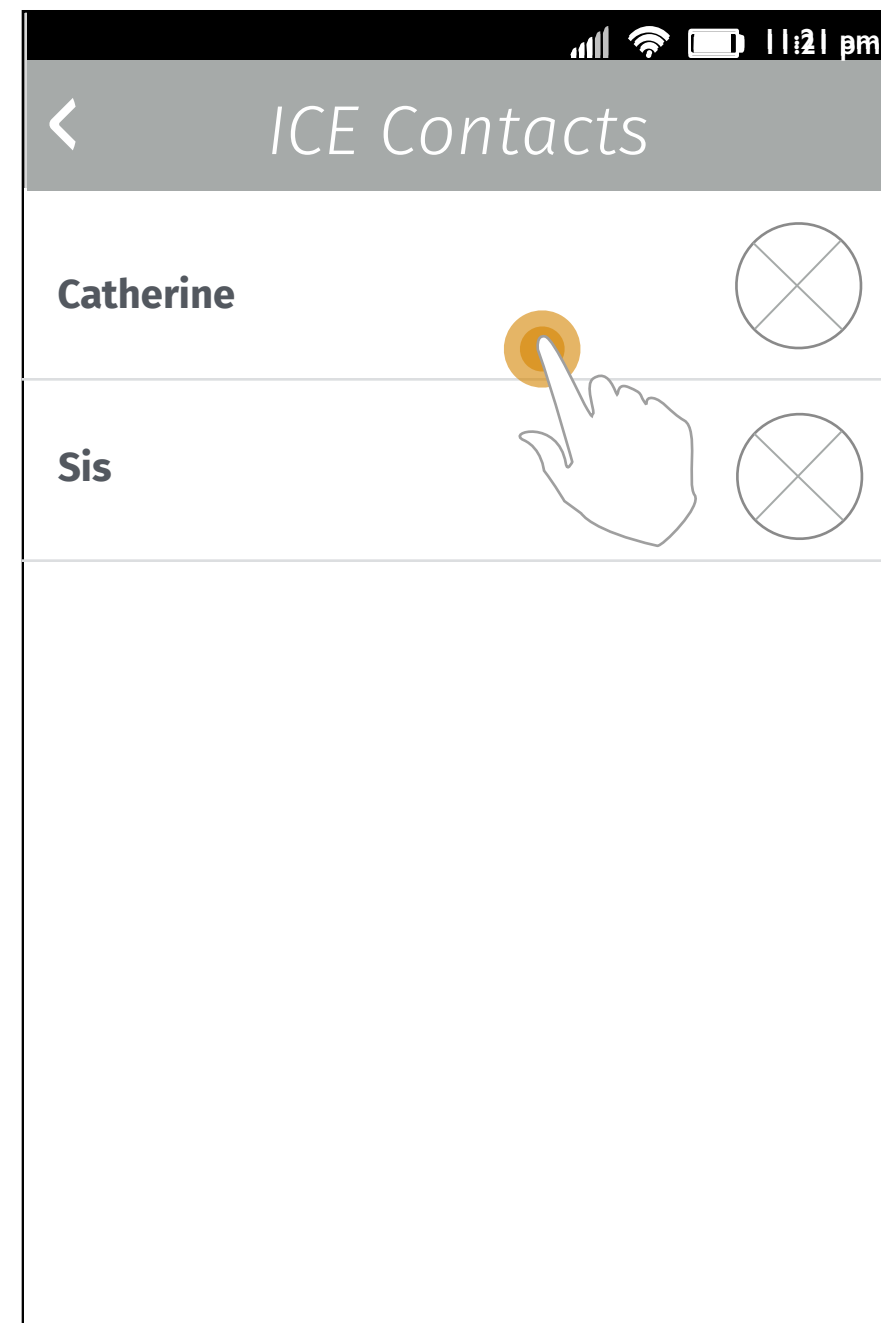
# Call ICE Contacts from Contacts APP

## 1. [Contacts list in Contacts APP]



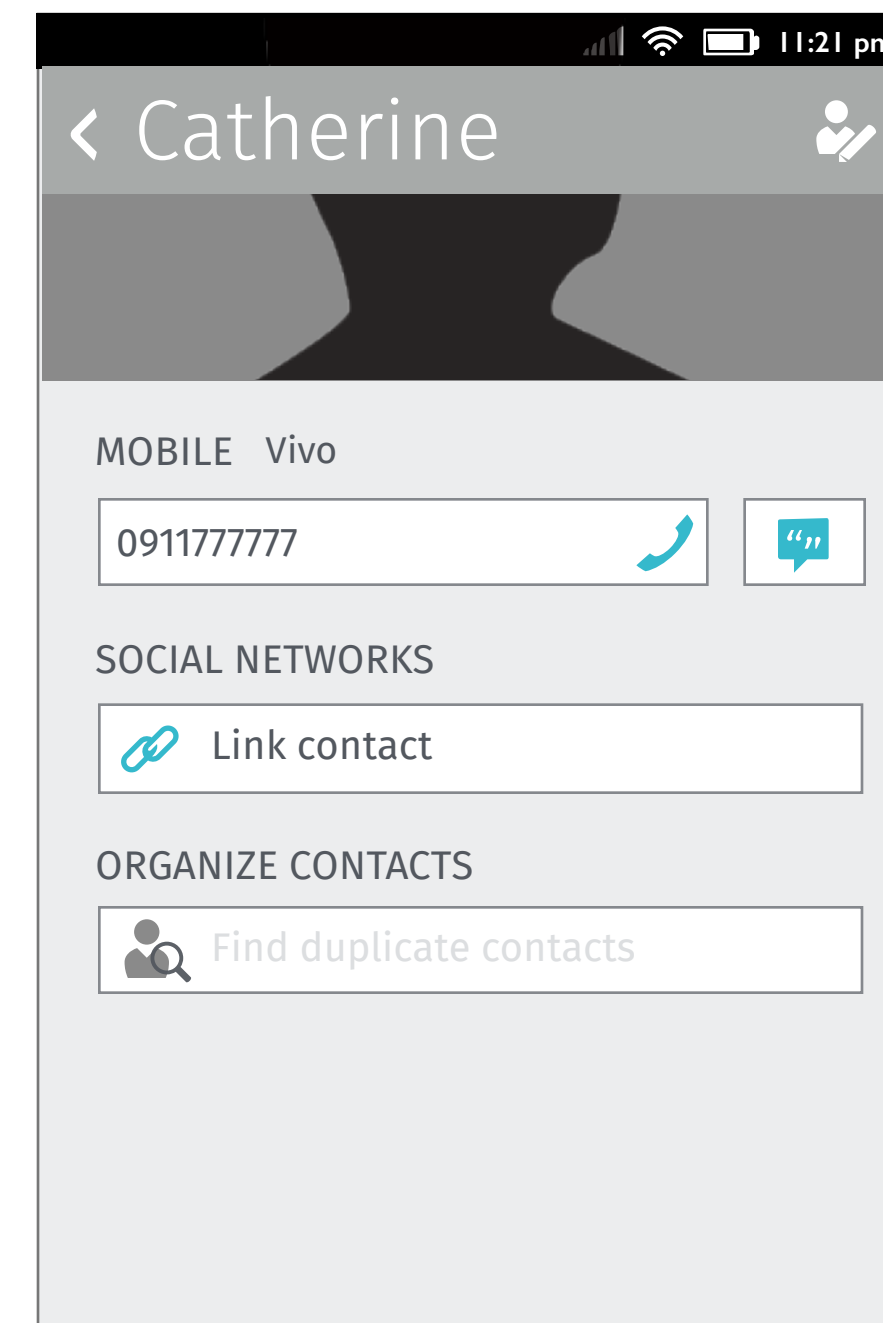
User taps the ICE Contacts section in Contacts APP.

## 2. [ICE contacts]



Display the contacts that user has set for emergency.

## 3. [Contact details]



Details of the contact slides in.

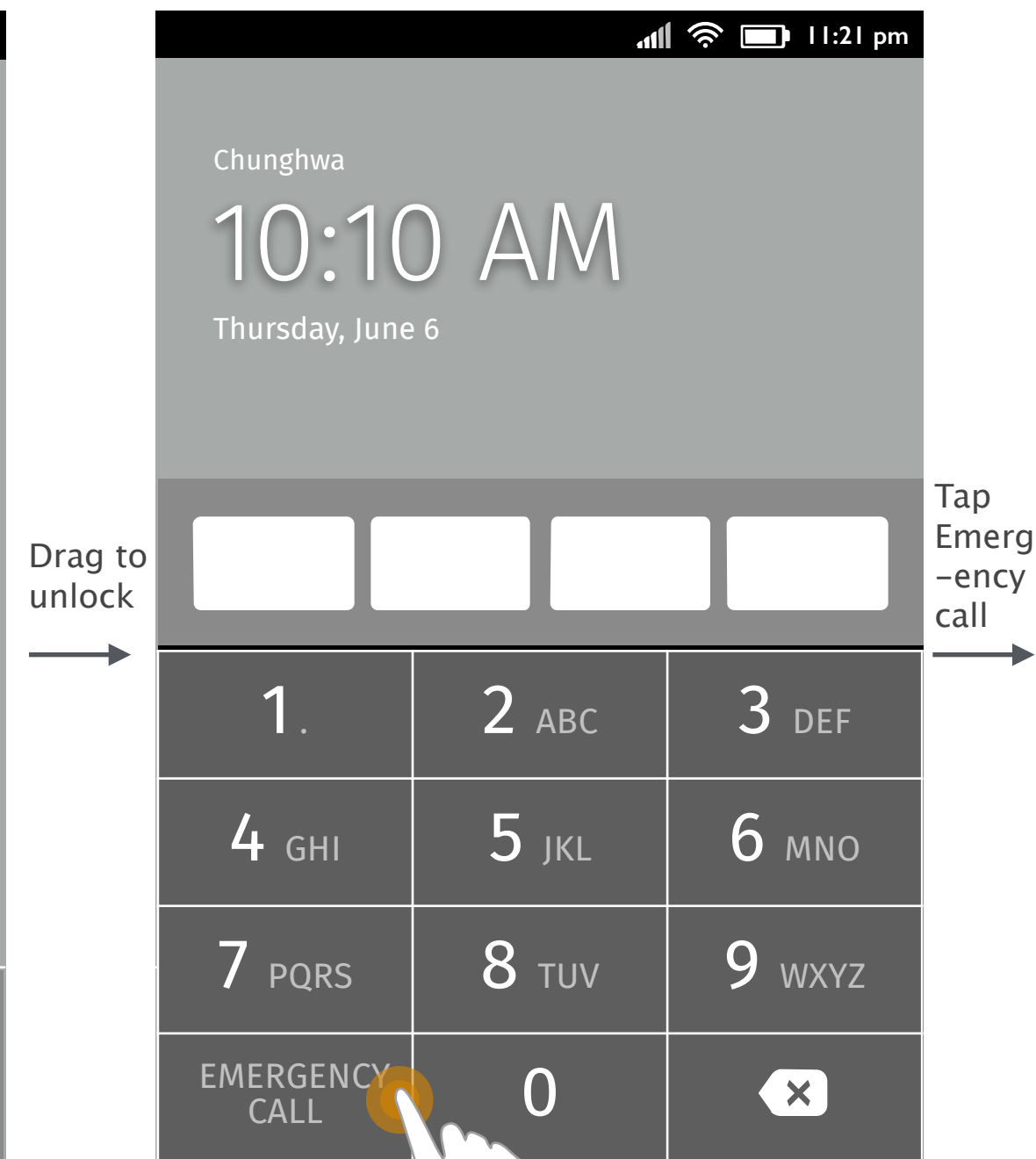
# Call ICE Contacts from Lockscreen (passcode set)

1. [Lockscreen]



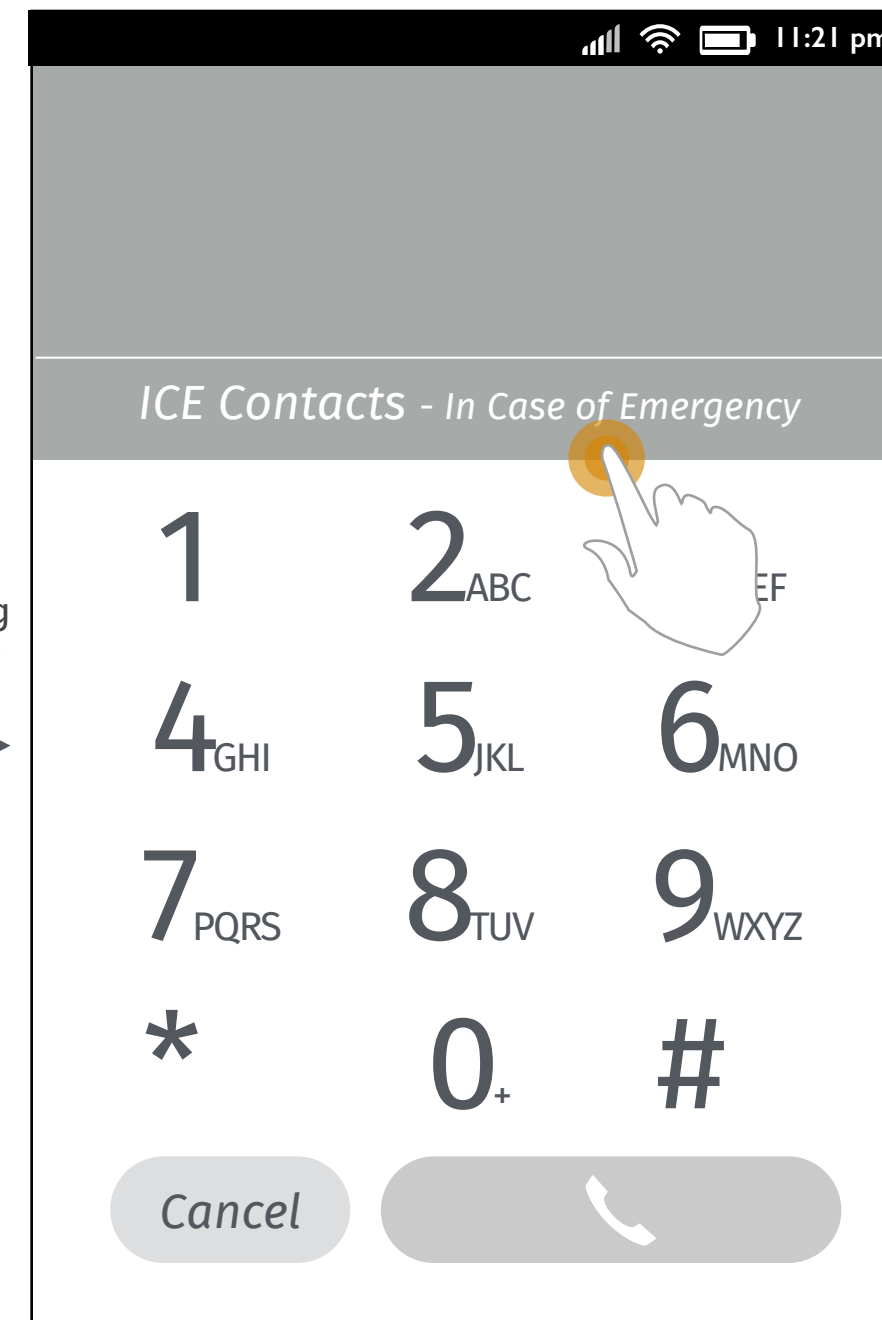
User unlocks the screen.

2. [Passcode keypad triggered]



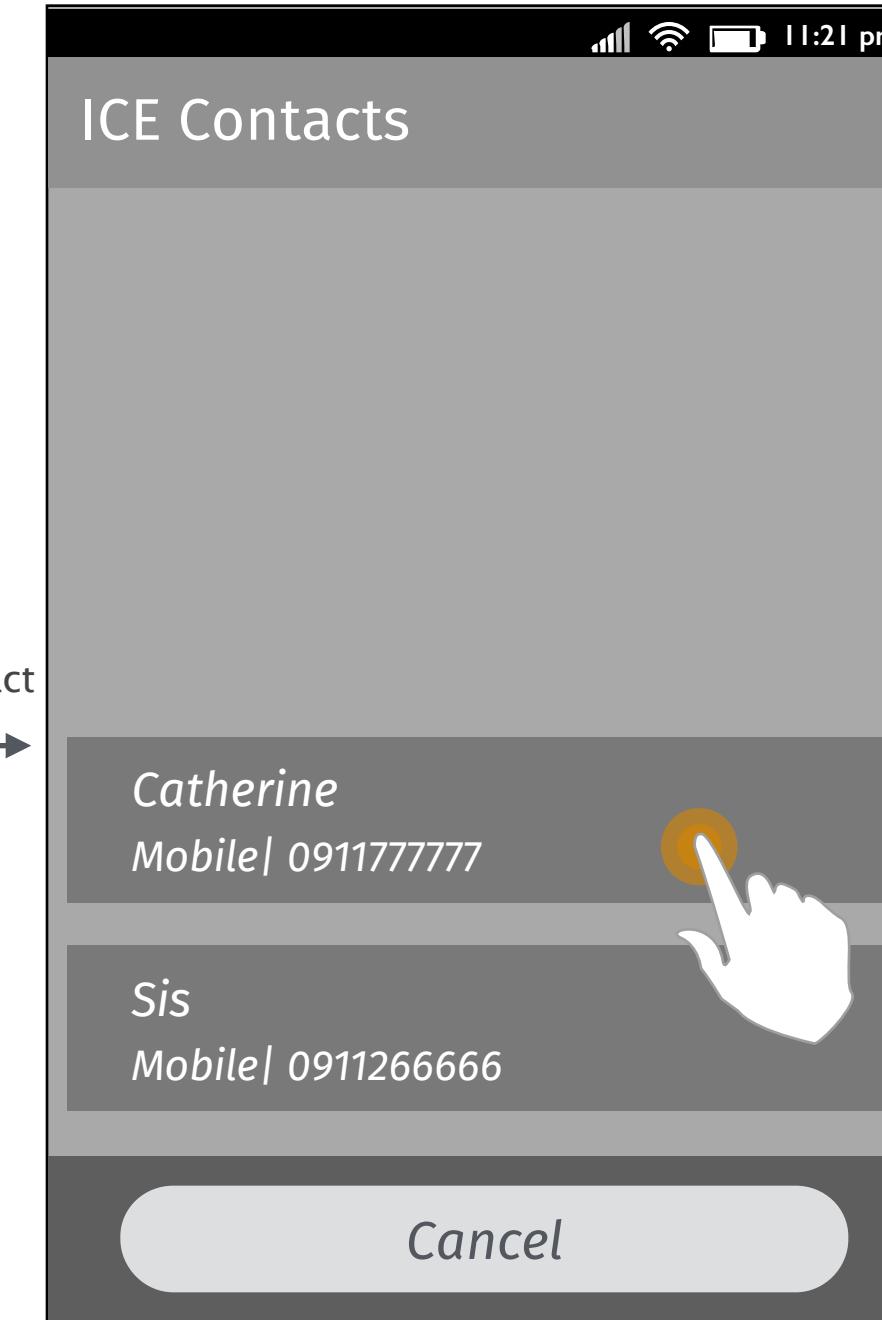
The keypad pops up and user taps the emergency call button.

3. [Dialer for emergency call]



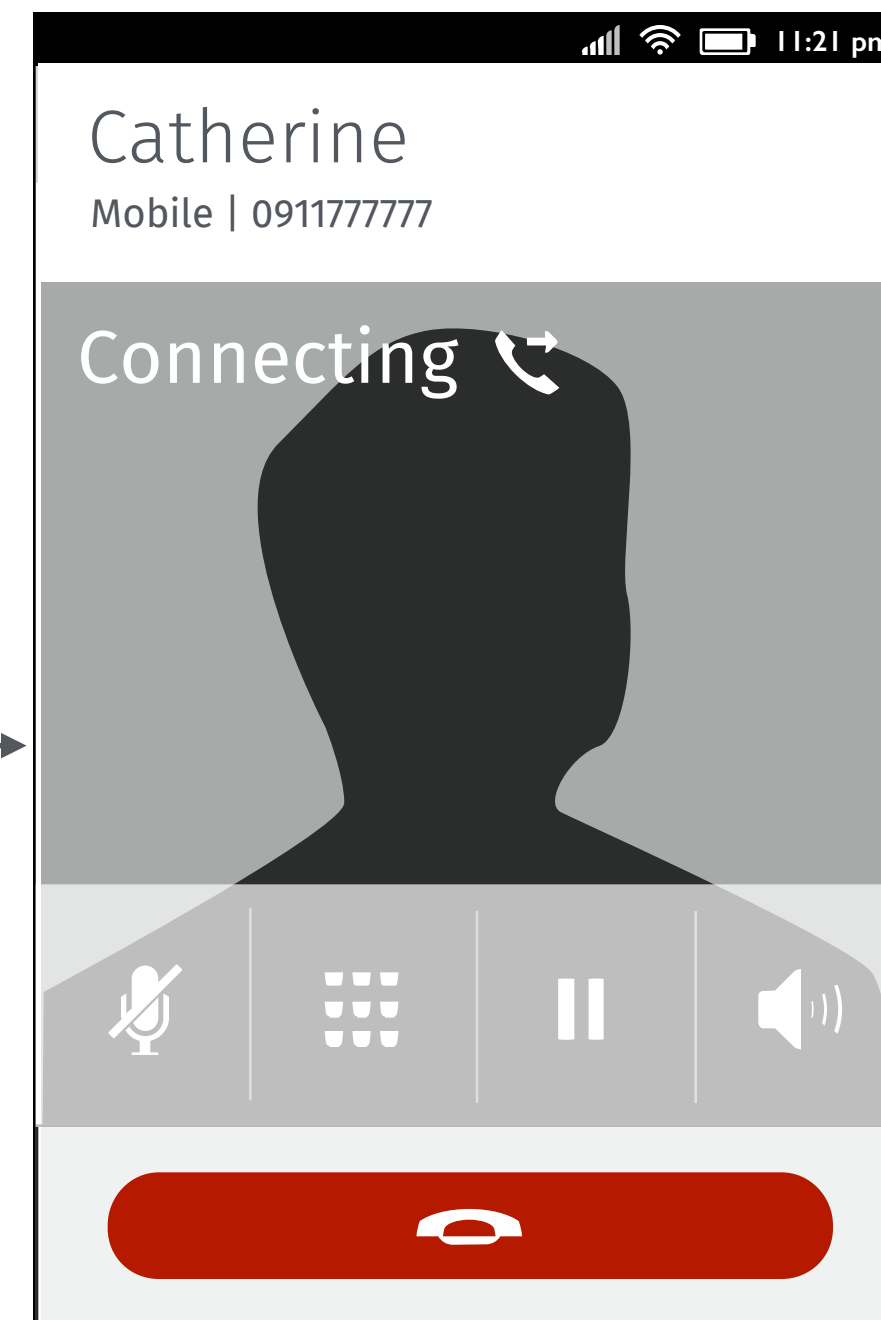
User will be redirected to Dialer (only for emergency calls). User can tap the ICE contacts section above the keypad to trigger the ICE contacts list.

4. [ICE Contacts menu]



The ICE Contacts menu pops up. User select one to make an emergency call.

5. [Call page]



The call is dialing out.

# Call ICE Contacts from Lockscreen (passcode set, but SIM locked)

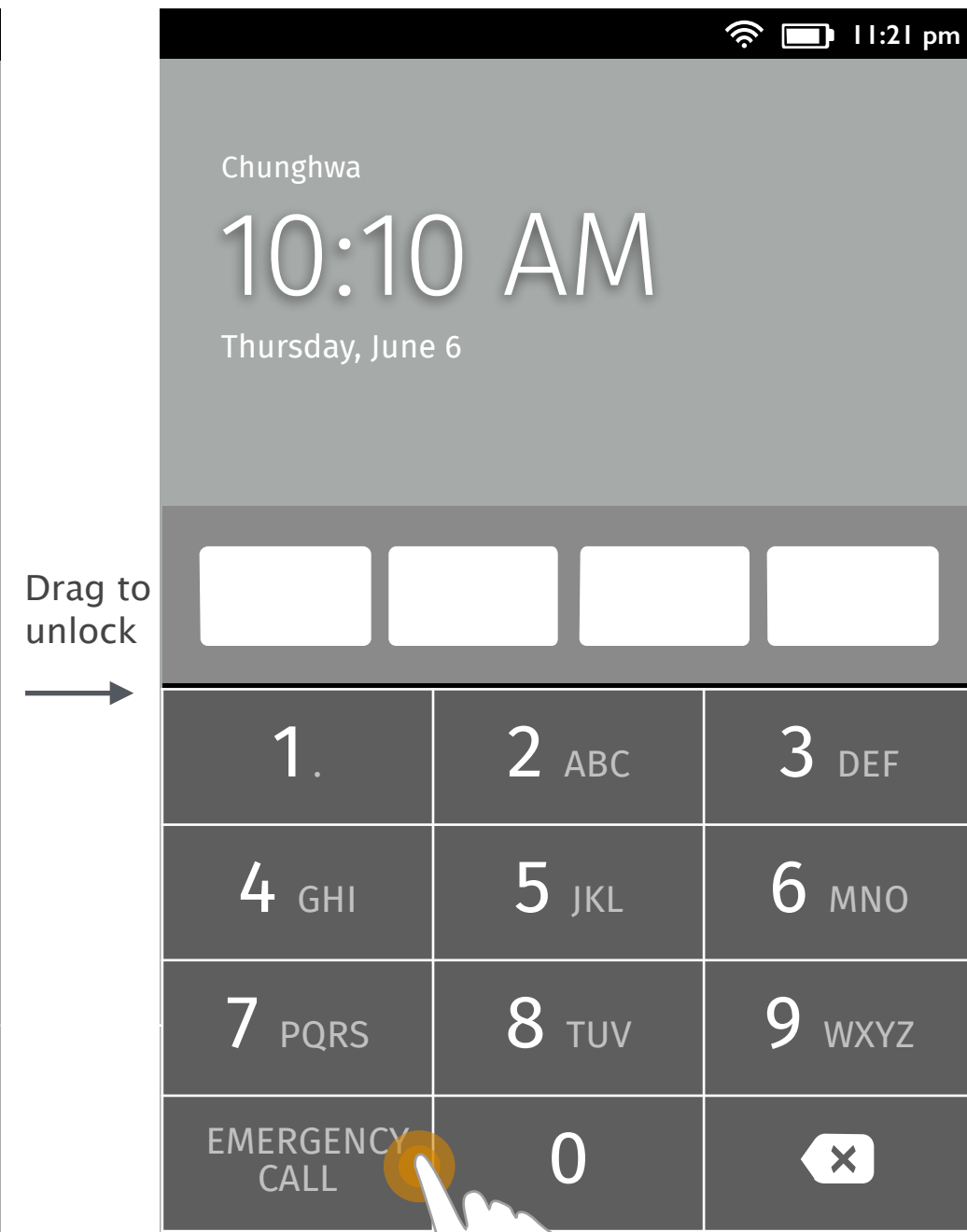
## 1. [Lockscreen]



The SIM PIN is locked. Hence there is no signal bar on status bar.

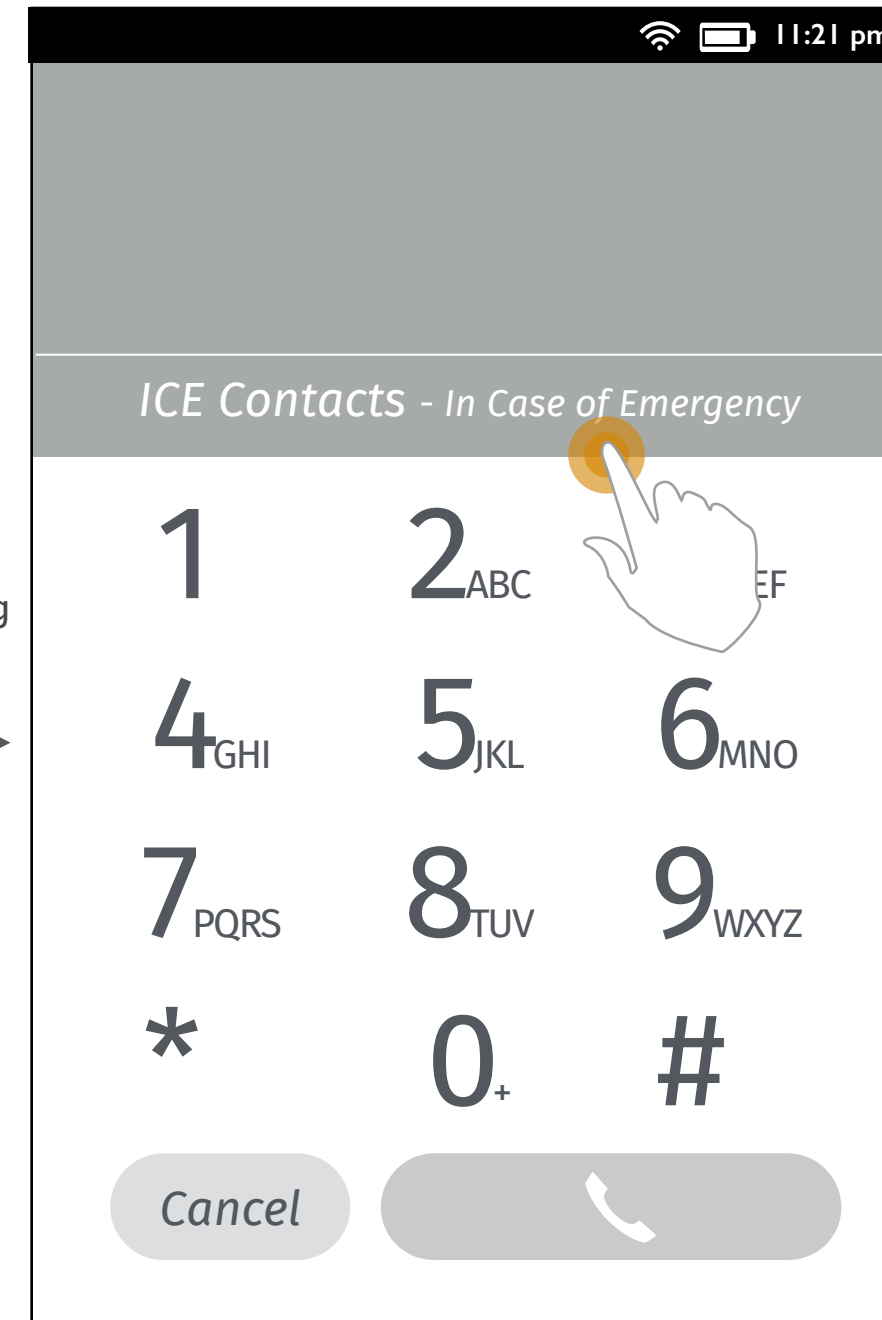
User unlocks the screen.

## 2. [Passcode keypad triggered]



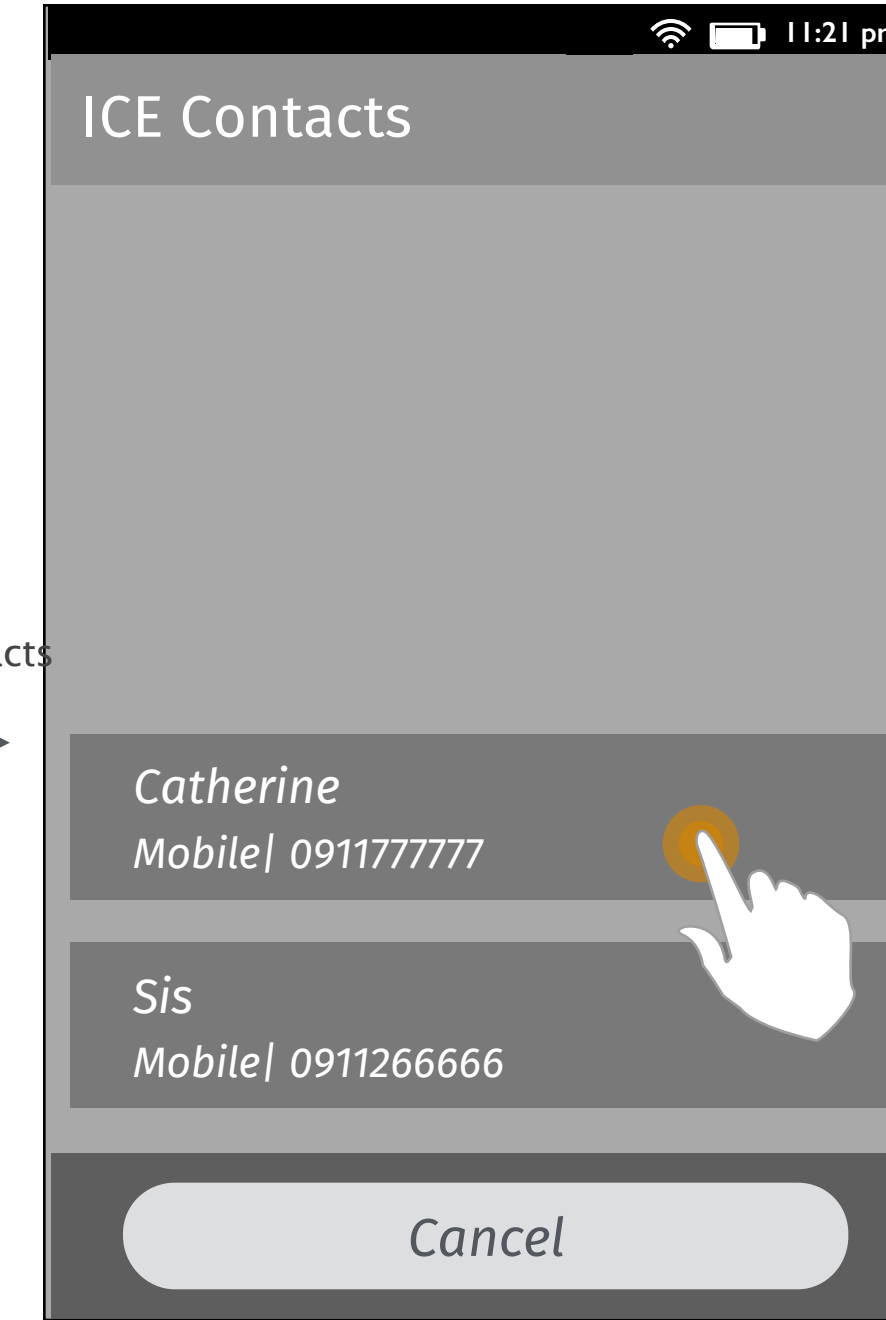
The keypad pops up and user taps the emergency call button.

## 3. [Dialer for emergency call]



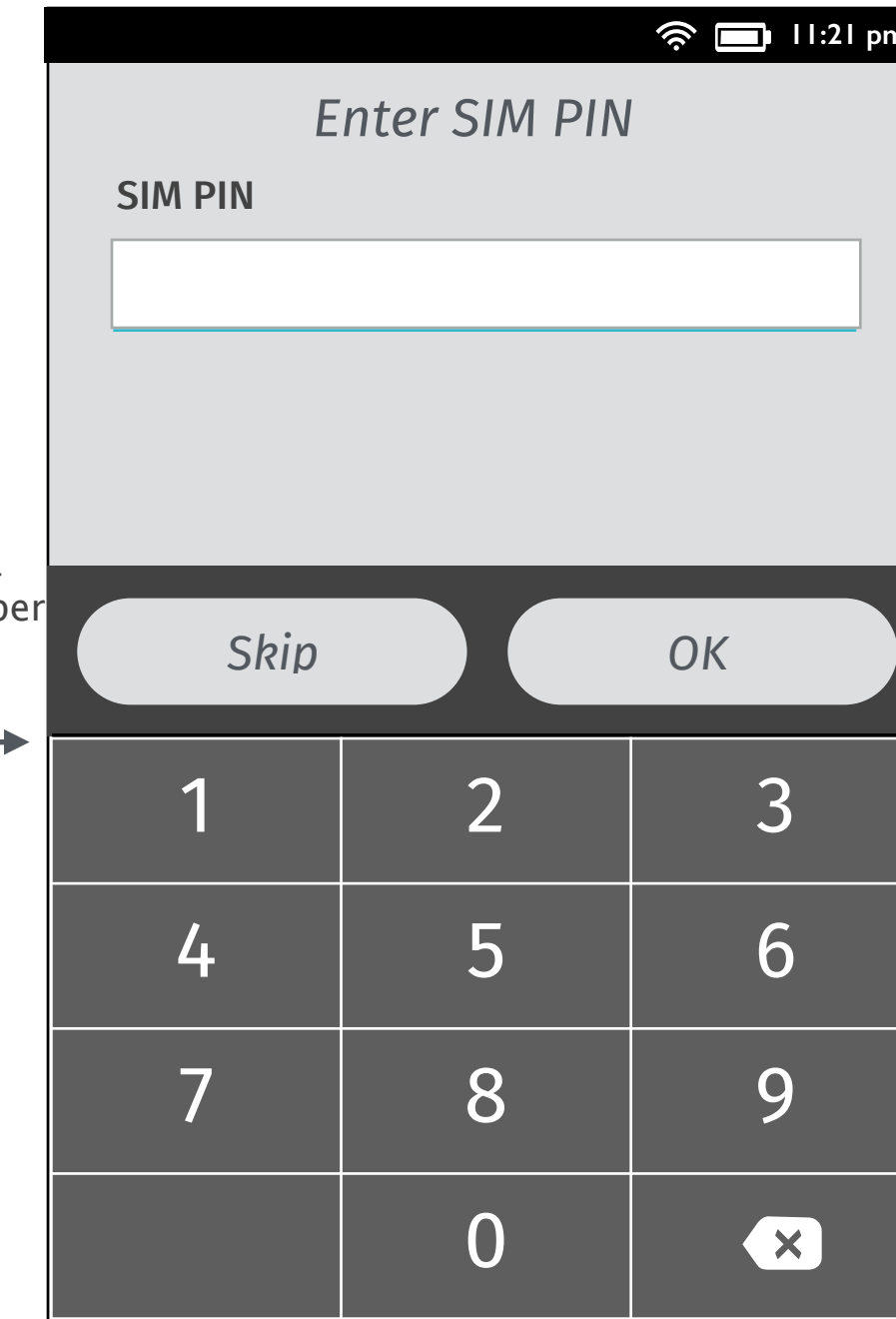
User will be redirected to Dialer (only for emergency calls). User can tap the ICE contacts section above the keypad to trigger the ICE contacts list.

## 4. [ICE Contacts menu]



The ICE Contacts menu pops up. User select one to make an emergency call.

## 5. [SIM PIN page]

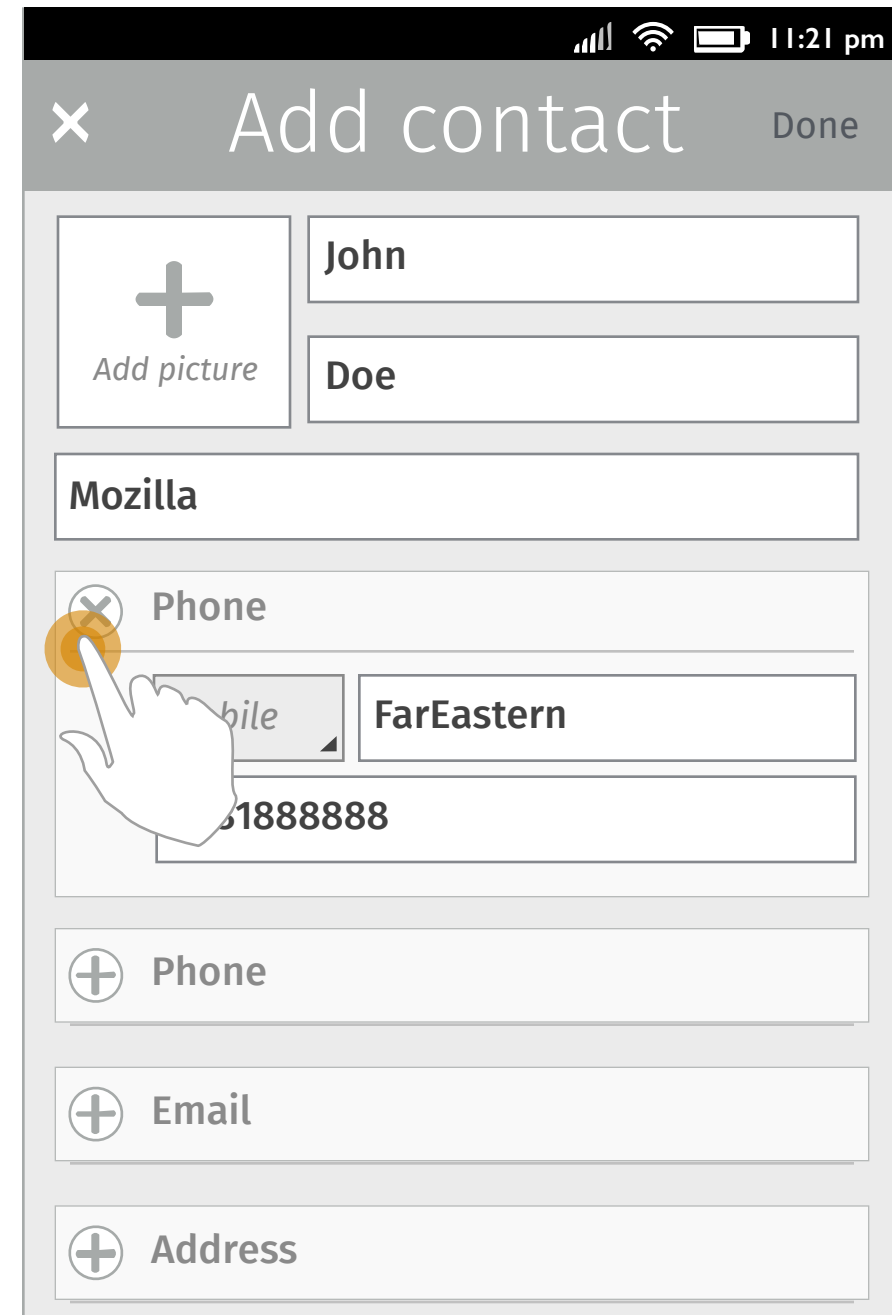


The SIM PIN entry page pops up. Input the PIN to call directly. Tap "Skip" will get back to Screen 4 and SIM keeps locked.

If it's dual SIM device, it will follow DSDS rule. Pop up the primary SIM page and the call will be dialed out from that SIM. If it's "Always" ask it will pop up the SIM picker when user place a call.

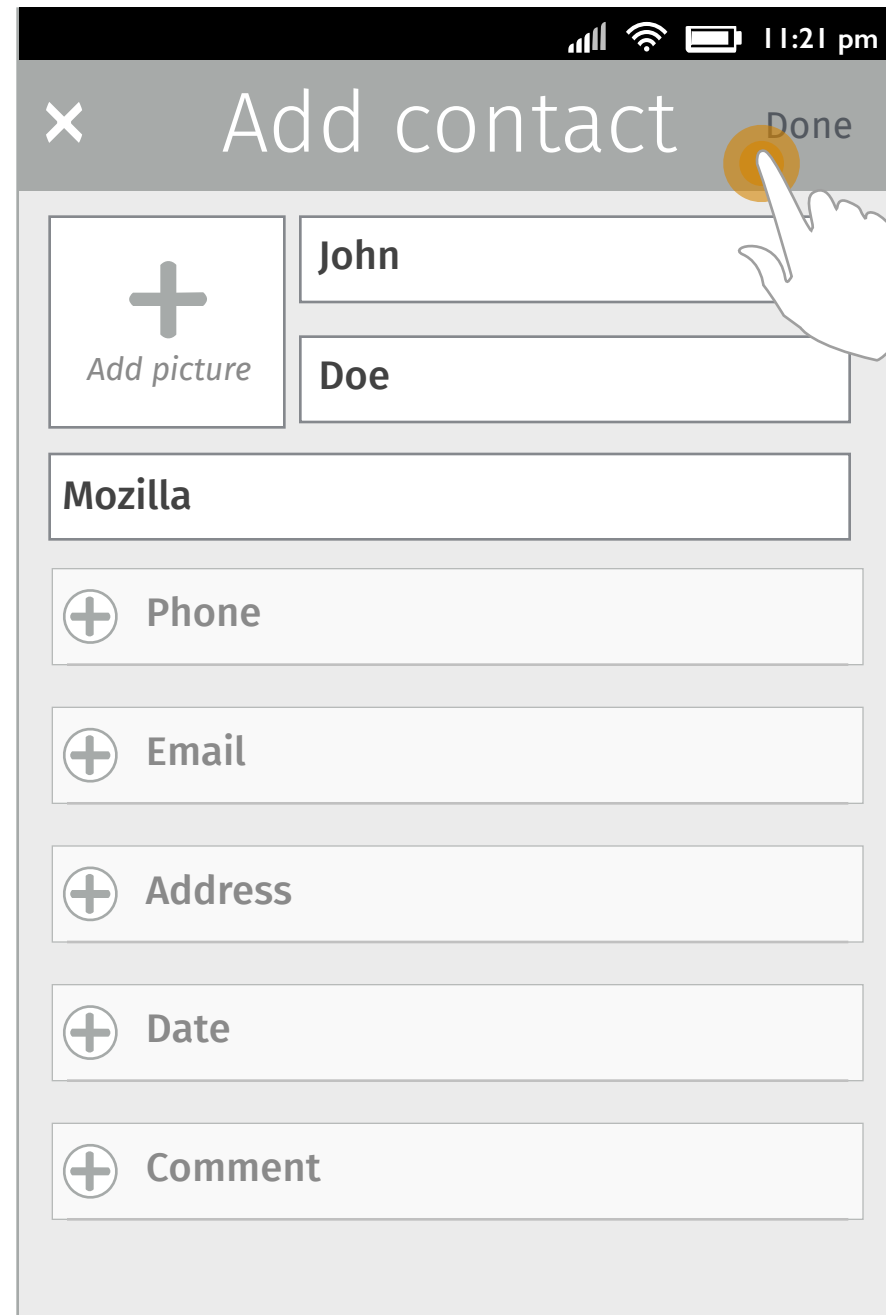
# Remove the number which is set for ICE (ICE contact's numbers deleted)

## 1. [Contact edit page]



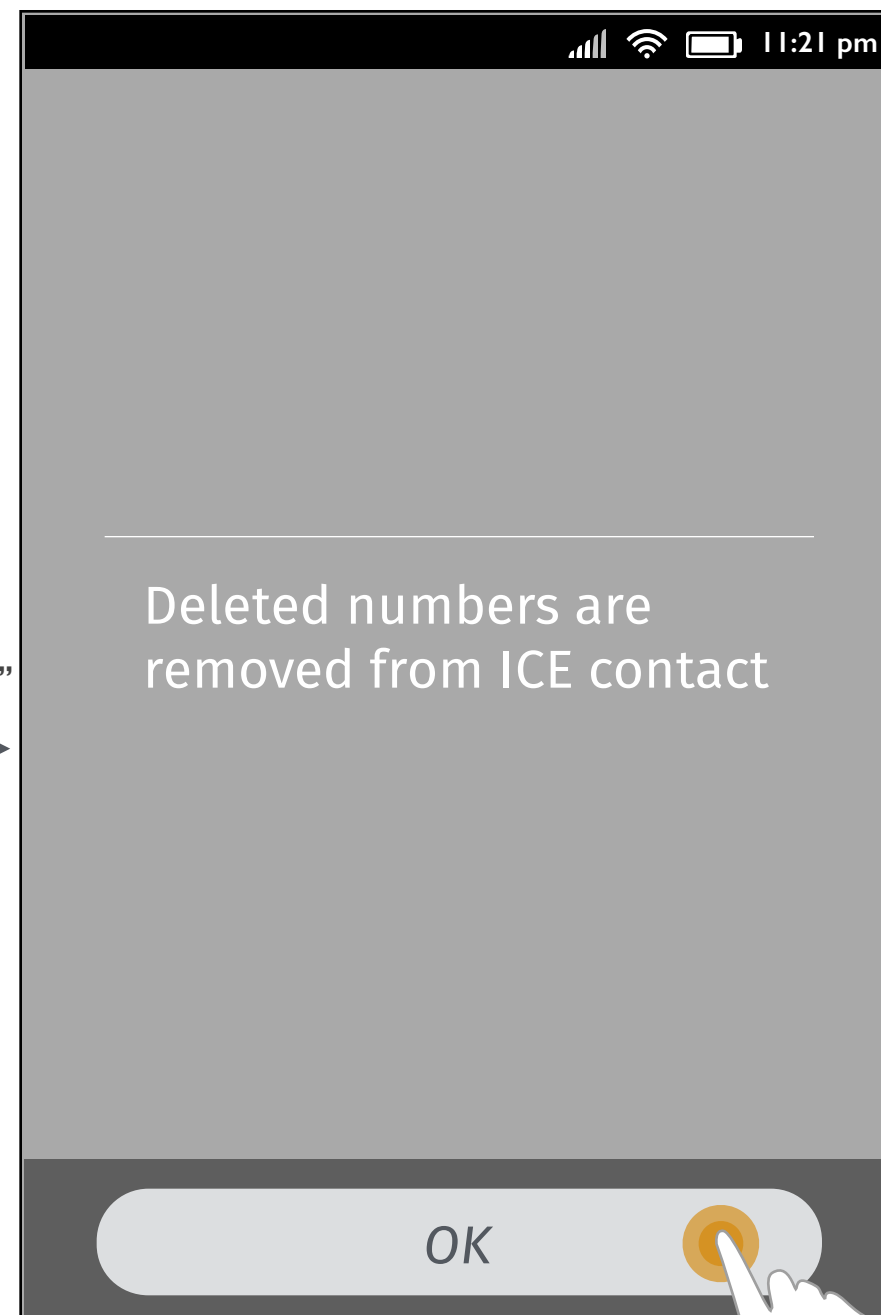
User taps the “x” button to delete the whole Phone numbers.

## 2. [Phone numbers deleted]



User taps Done to complete edit.

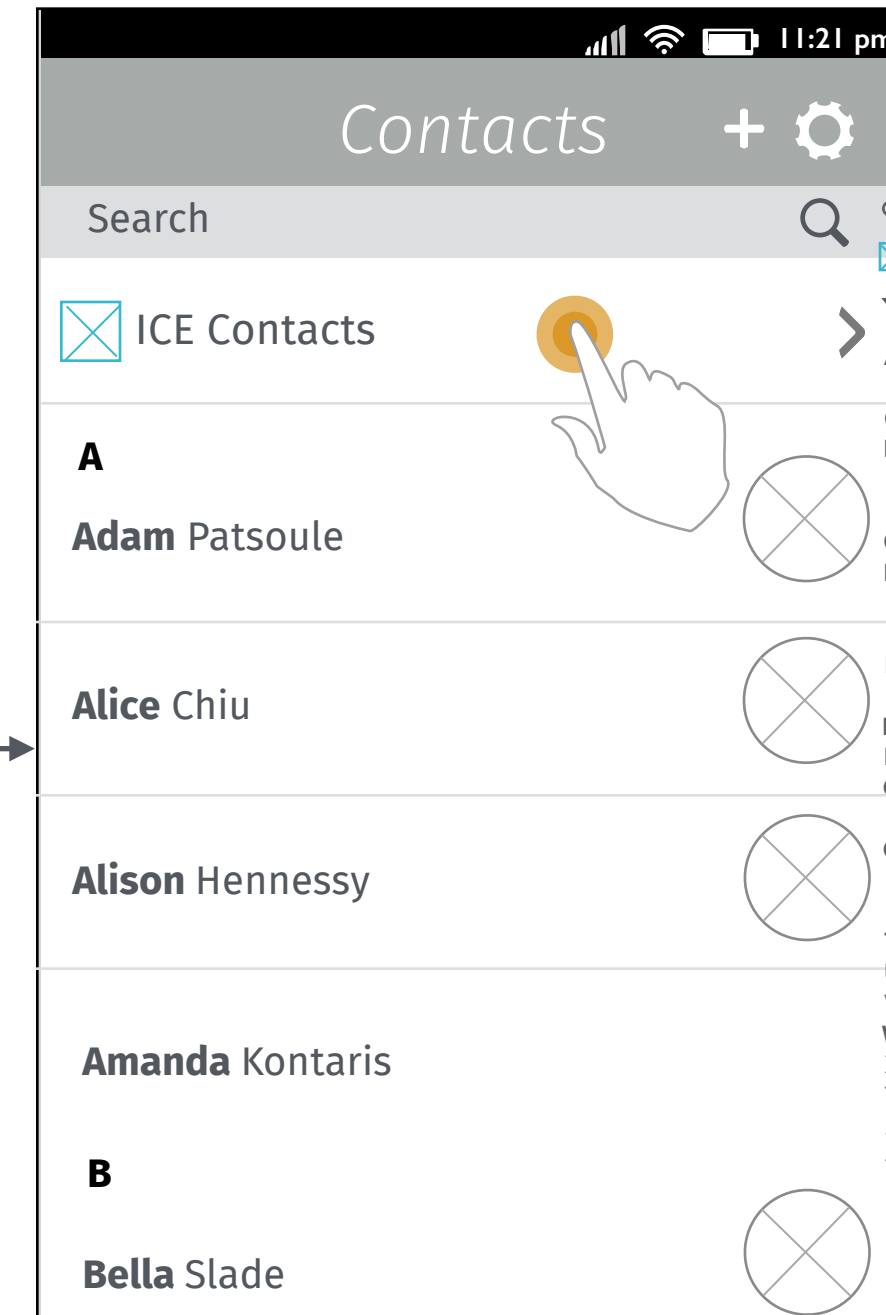
## 3. [Confirm window]



A confirm window pops up to inform users the deleted numbers are removed from ICE contact as well.

Taps OK to go back to the contact list or the ICE list (depends on where user accessed the edit page).

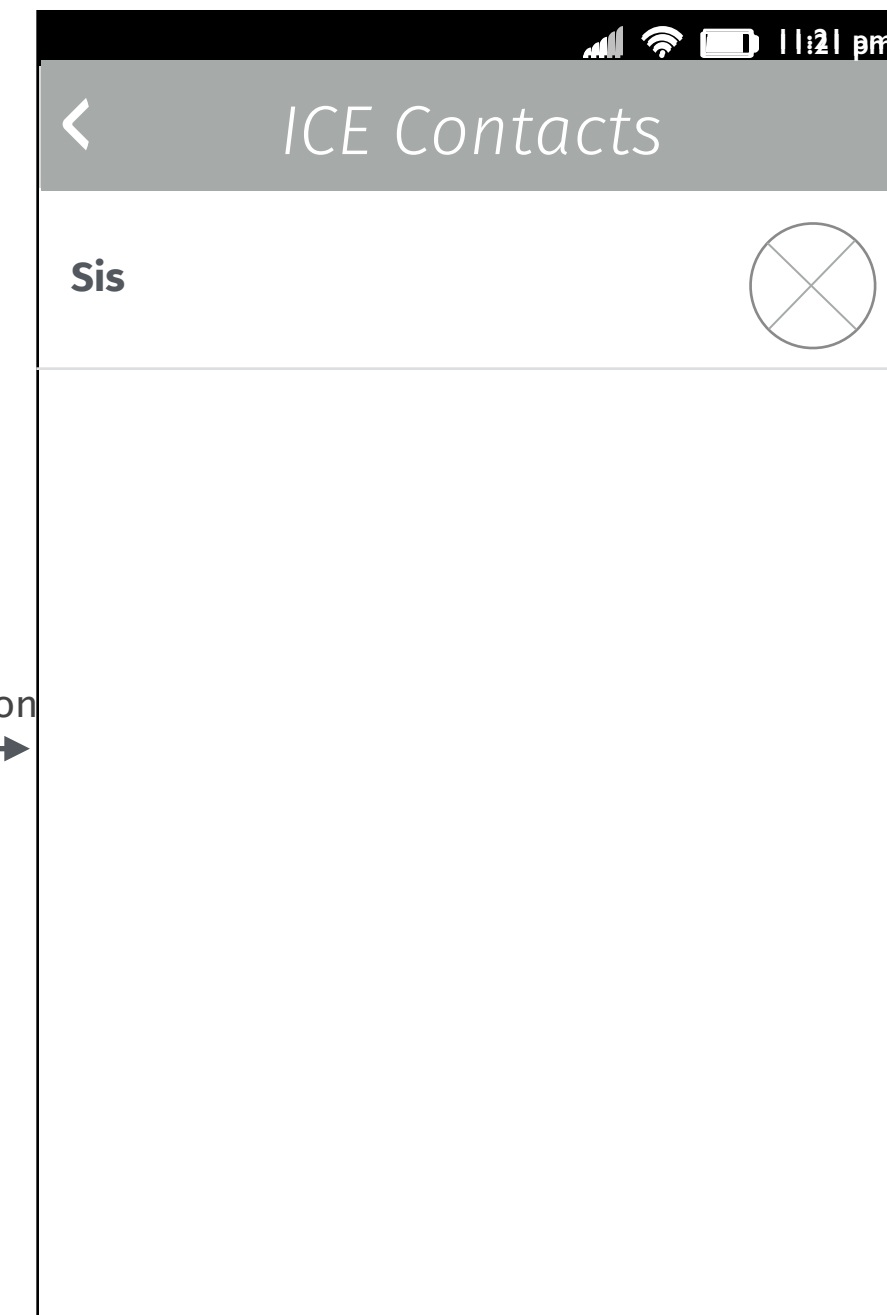
## 4. [ICE Contacts section]



If user only deleted the numbers of one the ICE contacts, the ICE section will still exist.

If user deletes all the numbers of both ICE contacts, the section will disappear.

## 5. [ICE Contacts list]



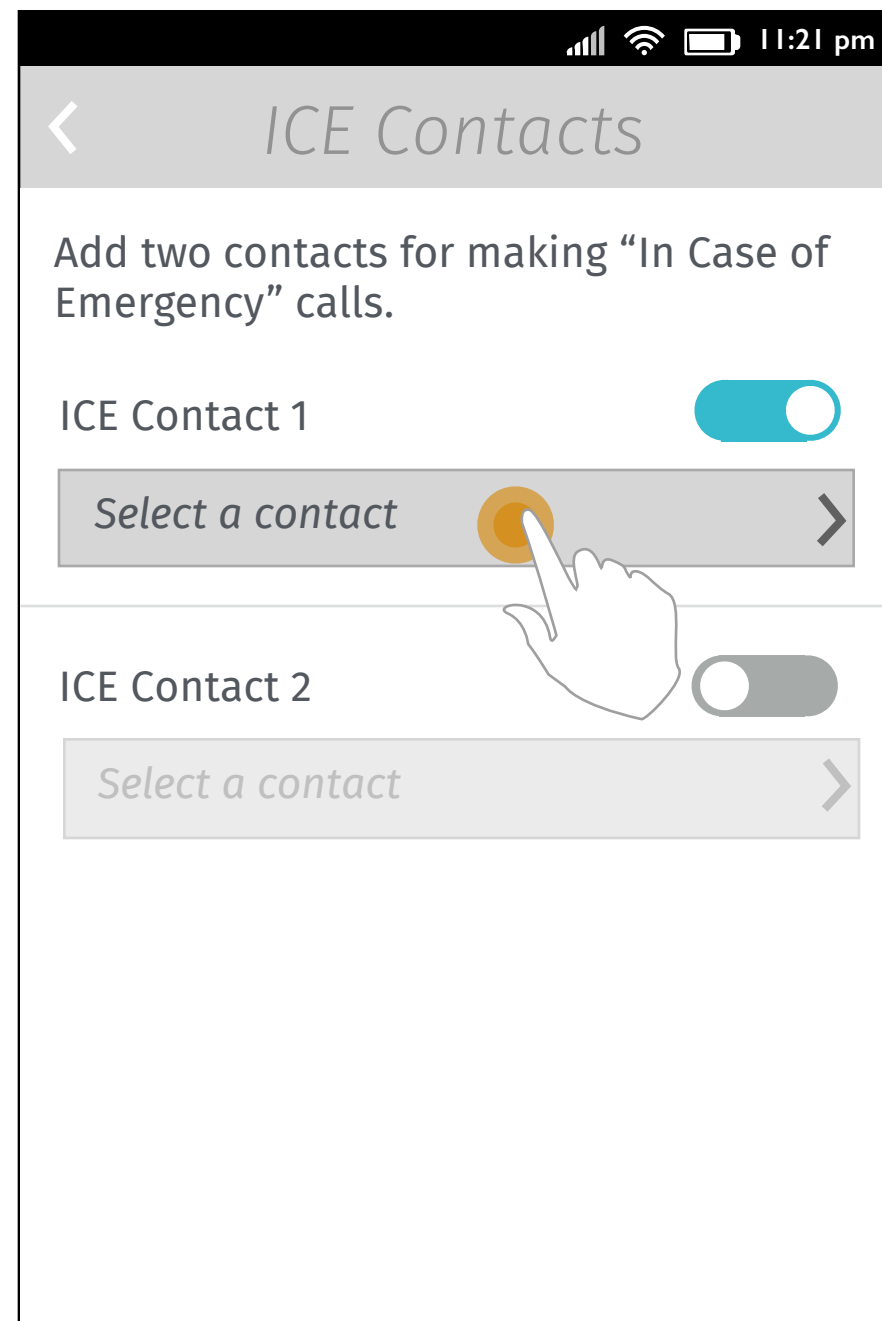
If the numbers of one of the ICE contacts are all deleted, the contact will be removed from the ICE list.

If that ICE contact has other numbers which are not deleted, he will still be in the list but the number will not displayed in contact details and the action menu triggered from Emergency call page.

# Error case (The contact doesn't have phone numbers set in the details)

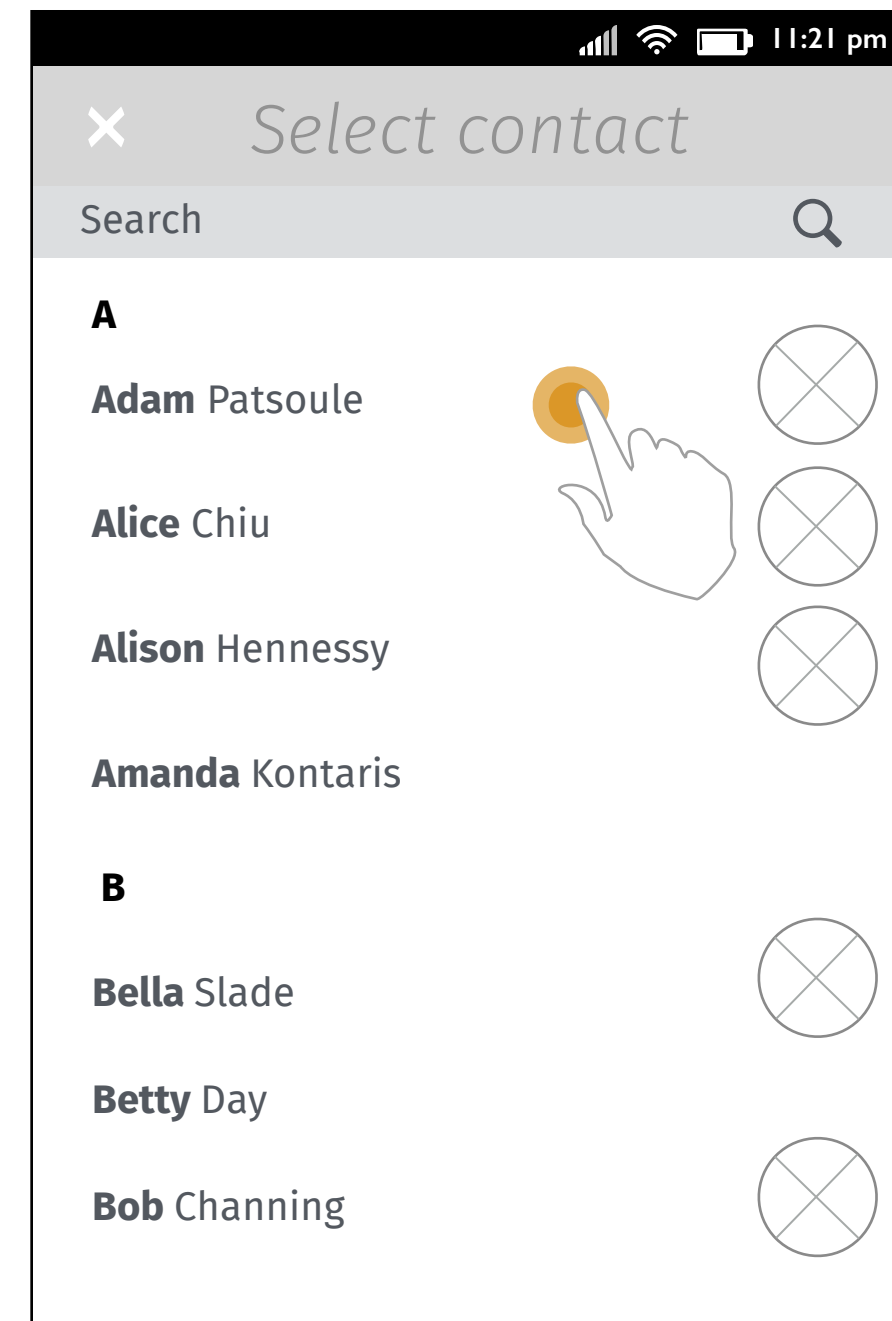
## 1. [ICE contacts settings]



User taps the action button to select a contact as the ICE contact 1.

Tap  
"Select a contact"

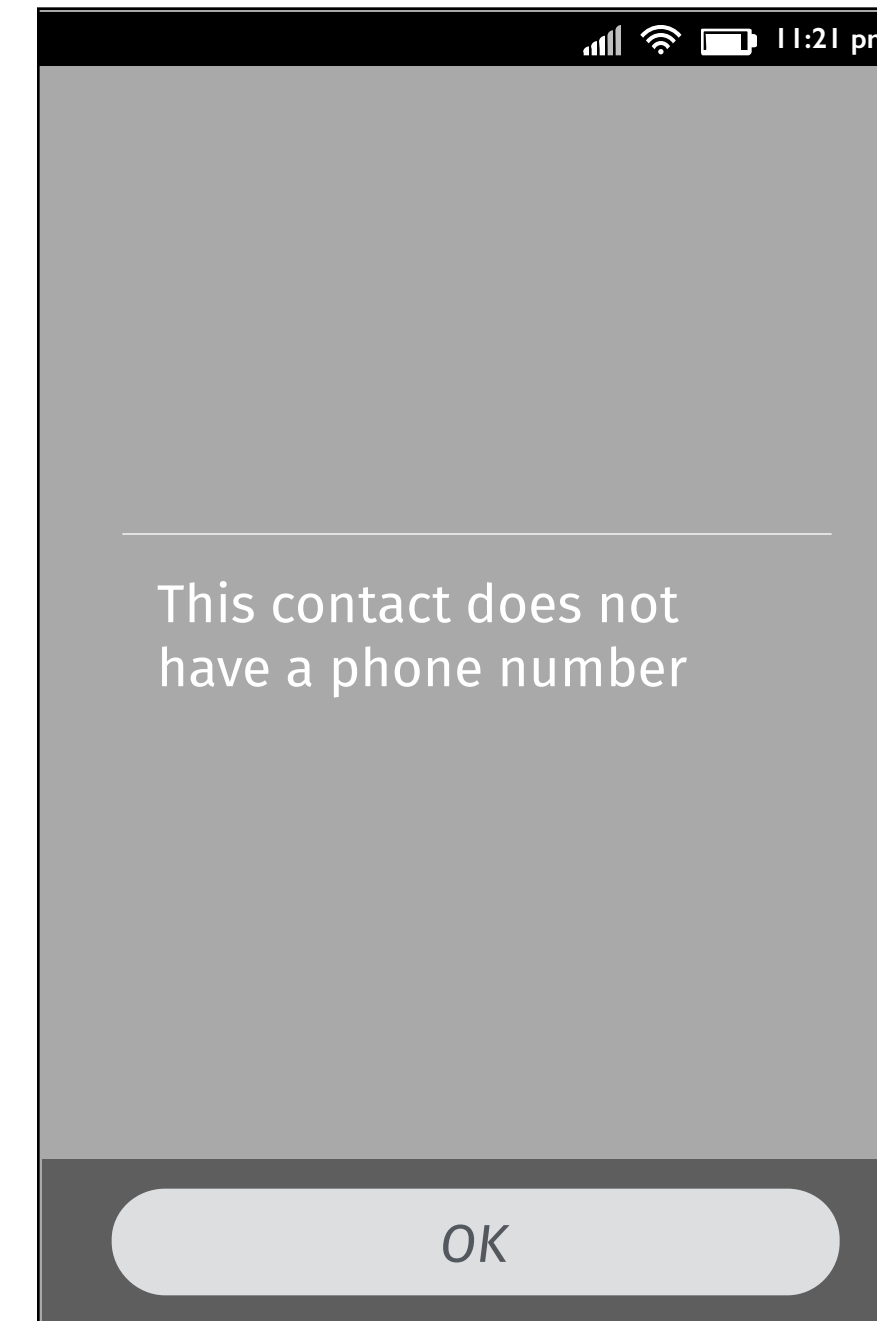
## 2. [Contact picker]



The contact "Adam Patsoule" is selected but doesn't have phone numbers set in contact details.

Select a contact

## 3. [Confirm window]



A confirm window pops up and inform user that the contact doesn't have phone numbers.

Tap OK to go back to Screen 2.
